# FEBC Ukraine



## July

**Sat 1** – Despite the political unrest in the Ukraine we are pleased to hear how the Lord is opening doors for people to be reached. FEBC Ukraine recently began broadcasting in a small town in Eastern Ukraine with a population of only 15 000. Being within close proximity to the conflict they are in dire need of our prayers and support.

# FEBC Russian Ministries

**Sun 2 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** St. Petersburg is experiencing an enormous breakthrough this year as they transition into using new technologies, Internet broadcasts and social media tools to reach millions of people. Many of these were unsaved youth who came to accept Jesus Christ through FEBC Russian online broadcasts. Join us in prayer this week for the Lord to continue to bless the team and their work.

**Mon 3** – Please pray for God's protection and favour to be with the broadcasters, who continues to interact with government officials on behalf of the ministry regardless of strong opposition.

**Tue 4** – Please pray for FEBC Russia's FM stations to be protected from government interference as attacks on Christian broadcasts continue.

**Wed 5** – FEBC has recently started broadcasting via an FM network of stations in the Siberian region of Tomsk. Please pray that many Siberians will come to accept Jesus as their personal Saviour.

**Thu 6** – Praise God for this listener who wrote "Thank you, friends; for your amazing broadcasts that I listen to on the Internet. Because of you, I became a Christian and I love my Saviour with all my heart!"

**Fri 7** – Please pray for the listeners in St. Petersburg and Moscow who do not have access to the Internet and cannot listen to FEBC online broadcasts. Internet access is readily available however, not many have smart phones or computers.

**Sat 8** – A new wife and mother describes the difficulty she had adapting to her new role and how FEBC's broadcasts changed her life: "I wake up with FEBC radio playing and it is amazing how much encouragement, joy, and wisdom I receive". Pray that more lives will be transformed.



# FEBC Kyrgyzstan

**Sun 9 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Praise the Lord for the successful launch of the new radio station in Toktogul, Kyrgyzstan. Strategically positioned, it is considered a gateway into the South of the country that will reach areas where FEBC didn't have a presence. The new radio frequency is one of only six in the entire region, and our signal is the strongest and clearest of all of them. Pray that those serving in the field will have the wisdom and determination to carry out the work to transform lives for the Kingdom of God and that many will be saved.

**Mon 10** – Please pray for the local partnerships and government leaders who allow orphanages, foster homes, drug and alcohol rehabilitation centres to voice their concerns, share their knowledge and suggest new ways the community can improve and support those in need.

**Tue 11** – Continue to pray for the First Generation Church in Karakol, who have only recently gained access to Christian material through our broadcasts. Pray that they will be able to share the Good News with their fellow countrymen.

**Wed 12** – 16 year old Valentina from Karakol is the only Christian in her school and she is daily facing indifference from her peers. Pray that the Lord will give her courage and that she will influence those around her.

**Thu 13** – 80% of the population is mostly Sunni Muslim and an estimated 11% are Russian Orthodox. Most do not have the privilege to know Jesus. Pray that the Lord will open doors for more people to be reached through our broadcasts.

**Fri 14** – Social orphans are children whose parents leave the country to pursue work abroad. They are often left to fend for themselves and work from a young age. Pray that the Lord will intervene.

**Sat 15** – Domestic violence, alcoholism and orphaned children are a few of the many struggles people of this nation are faced with due to the extreme poverty and lack of opportunity. Pray that the Lord will intervene and change these people's lives.





## FEBC Kazakhstan

**Sun 16 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** The First Generation Church of Kazakhstan has been experiencing tremendous persecution as they are required to have permits to worship in places other than the registered local religious buildings. As the majority of Kazakhs are culturally Muslim, the First Generation Church does not have official designated places of worship and use their homes for this purpose. Recently 22 people were caught and fined because of this. Please pray that the Lord will intervene in this nation so that Christians will be allowed to practice their faith openly.

**Mon 17 –** N\* is a young follower of Christ and experiences severe persecution from his family, who believes he betrayed them. Pray that God will strengthen him, and others like him, in their faith.

**Tue 18 –** Please pray for Rev. Nurlan, who hosts daily FEBC talk shows, and the other broadcasters that God will give them wisdom and inspire them to minister to the many broken families who need Christ.

**Wed 19 –** FEBC hosts a weekly talk-show on fatherhood and are in need of financial support – the homes are rampant with domestic violence and absent fathers. Pray that the Lord will provide the necessary funds to continue this work.

**Thu 20 –** Recently the government implemented new laws that have made it difficult for our ministry here. Please pray that the Lord will turn this political situation around in our favour, so that more will be reached.

**Fri 21 –** We welcome Laura our newest broadcaster in Almaty. Please pray that Laura's broadcast will find its way to the hearts of the Kazakh listeners and that the Lord will give her wisdom and understanding to share the Good News.

**Sat 22 –** Ruslan, FEBC's leader in Almaty is producing a weekly talk show on the Internet. Pray that the Lord will bless and protect him, his team and their work.

## FEBC Mongolia

**Sun 23 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** With more than 10 radio stations on air, FEBC Mongolia is able to reach thousands of communities across their nation. However, with two-thirds of the country being nomadic, moving their homes where it best suits their animals to graze, there is still a great need for support. With the funding for three new stations underway, this would place the entire country within reach of receiving the gospel through FEBC's broadcasts. Please pray that the Lord

will open doors so that the people in remote areas will be reached by our broadcasts to receive the Good News.

**Mon 24** – Please pray for the team at Wind FM who recently began producing programs that will address common problems affecting men and fathers.

**Tue 25** – Too often domestic problems are kept in the dark, but by bringing the issues out into the light, families can understand and address their problems. Please pray to God to be with our listeners and give them the courage to share their grievances with us.

**Wed 26** – Pray for Batjargal Tuvshinsengel, the Director of FEBC Mongolia, and his team as they are faced with many challenges having to create programs to meet the increasingly demanding needs of the people.

**Thu 27** – Pray for listeners like Naran-Od who wrote: “The programs helped me through

my darkest days, until now I still believe that Jesus has healed my broken heart through your radio programs.”

**Fri 28** – Within the population of 3.2 million, only an estimated 100 000 people are Christians. Please pray for God to open new doors so that the rest will also be reached by our broadcasts.

**Sat 29** – Please pray for our station in Sainshand City. The city has 30 000 people who are predominantly Buddhist. Pray that the team will be inspired to produce broadcasts that will capture their hearts.



## ***FEBC Chinese Ministries***

**Sun 30 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** FEBC Hong Kong is the major production centre for our China broadcasts. It produces over 200 hours of programs monthly in Mandarin, Cantonese and other minority languages broadcasted to over seven different ethnic groups reaching several million people. Even though the locals have been open to receive the gospel, only 4% of the Chinese population are Christians. Join us this week as we pray that God will move in China, as FEBC face many new challenges with recent alterations imposed on their laws concerning religious freedom.

**Mon 31** – Recently 26 new laws were en-

forced by the government imposing several restrictions. Pray that FEBC will continue to be inspired with new ideas to reach those who are still unreached.

### **August**

**Tue 1** – Pray for the Liangyou Theological Seminary as they equip the Chinese people to become pastors and ministers of the Word of God through their seminars.

**Wed 2** – Please pray for the programmers who developed multiple new platforms to spread the gospel. The daily broadcast now



reaches more than 26 ethnic people groups in the Southwest region of China.

**Thu 3** – According to official statistics, the population of Mobile Internet users in China is 600 million people, nearly half the population. Pray that the Lord will inspire the team with new ideas and strategies as they use mobile apps to reach these people.

**Fri 4** – Please pray that the Lord will call more people to help in reaching the numerous ethnic minorities in Yunnan, China. Pray that He will send people to help distribute SD cards.

**Sat 5** – Please pray for the FEBC International stations which daily produce 33.5 hours of programs for the Chinese people.



## ***FEBC USA - Chinese Broadcasts in LA***

**Sun 6 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Recently FEBC launched its first Mandarin-language broadcasts to Chinese listeners in the greater Los Angeles area on AM 900. The aim is to reach a large segment of recent Chinese immigrants in Southern California who only speak Mandarin. The show, called “Knowing You”, airs weekly from 8pm till 9pm daily and from 1pm till 2pm on Sundays. Join us as we pray for these broadcasts and for the many new listeners. Pray that they will accept Christ through listening to our broadcasts.

**Mon 7** – Pray for our team of broadcasters at



AM 900 who are working arduously to create and produce insightful broadcasts that will effectively reveal Christ to this community.

**Tue 8** – Please pray for the producers, that God will inspire their program content and give them the determination and perseverance they need to function in excellence.

**Wed 9** – Please pray that the Lord will send skilful people to support their ministry in Los Angeles and for all around financial provision.

**Thu 10** – Even though these people may be surrounded by Western culture, they still draw near to their national identity which includes the practice of Buddhism. Pray that the community will have an encounter with Christ and receive salvation.

**Fri 11** – In every community there are needs – please pray that the team will be inspired with practical ideas to address the specific needs of the people through their broadcasts.

**Sat 12** – At the start of a new project there

are always challenges - pray that God's favour will rest upon the team to see them through, protect them and guide them in their daily duties.

## ***FEBC Vietnam***

**Sun 13 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Vietnam is a country of 92 million people, most of who live in suffocating poverty. With less than 2% knowing Jesus, millions may die without ever hearing of God's eternal plans for them. To seize these God-given opportunities that will expand our reach into dark corners where Christ is opposed, the gospel is repressed and believers are regularly persecuted by the authorities and even their own families - they need our prayers to cover these Christians in Vietnam. Pray with us for the work FEBC does to reach into Vietnam with broadcasts.

**Thu 17 –** With several minority groups scattered in remote areas, it is only through radio that they might ever come to know Christ. Pray that the Lord will continue to bless FEBC's ministry there.

**Fri 18 –** Please pray that God will inspire the program content for these Vietnamese broadcasts, that this will truly touch their troubled hearts and change their lives forever.

**Mon 14 –** Pray that the 20 ethnic minority language programs will touch the hearts and lives of the people and that new programs will be developed in more minority languages for communities who are still unreached.

**Tue 15 –** Please pray for our team in the United States that continues to develop programs which are then sent to the Philippines to be broadcasted into Vietnam.

**Wed 16 –** As a nation battling poverty, it is filled with broken homes where families

**Sat 19 –** Please pray for the thousands of Christians living under persecution in Vietnam. Pray for their safety and that God will strengthen their faith.



## ***FEBC Korea - Reaching North Korea***

**Sun 20 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** North Korea's Kim II Sung who ruled in the 1970s, made his followers swear to follow him, and only him and thus created a "Juche" ideology which promotes the belief in self-reliance. Those who refused to follow him and renounce their own religious beliefs were executed, or deported to remote concentration camps. As a result of this, the then established Christian churches, have ceased completely or now operate underground. Join us in prayer this week as we pray for the team who produces broadcasts for the people and the families who are persecuted. Pray that

the Lord will bring North Korea into a new era of religious freedom.

**Mon 21** – Please pray for our team on Jeju Island in South Korea, the main station from which programs are broadcasted into North Korea. Pray that the Lord will grant them passage to reach more people.

**Tue 22** – Pray for the families that profess Christ. Pray that the Lord will protect and guide them in spite of the persecution that they might be facing.

**Wed 23** – Pray that the Lord will bless FEBC's ministry in this nation and enable them to reach areas that are under heavy surveillance by the government.

**Thu 24** – Pray for our broadcasters who risk their lives and the lives of their loved ones back home as the broadcast into North Korea.

**Fri 25** – Outside news sources and other forms of information are strictly forbidden. For most, the radio is the only medium through which they might ever hear the gospel. Pray that the Lord will bring a breakthrough through FEBC's radio ministry in this oppressed nation.

**Sat 26** – Pray for this listener, who was imprisoned for marrying a Chinese man. She began listening to FEBC's broadcasts and said that through these broadcasts her entire family came to know Christ.

## FEBC Cambodia

**Sun 27 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Currently we have the opportunity to expand our reach to the most remote provinces in Cambodia. Earlier this year 289 speaker boxes were distributed to 14 villages and nine communes of Takeo, Koh Kong and Kompong Som provinces. Pray that these people's hearts will be touched and lead to accept Christ through FEBC's programs and that many more unsaved people will be reached this year.

**Mon 28** – Earlier this year 51 speaker boxes were distributed by our team to two remote villages in the Koh Kong province in Southwest Cambodia. Pray that these people will receive salvation by listening to the

programs.

**Tue 29** – Pray with us for the Cambodian team who are working to reach out to the most remote areas of their nation. Pray that the Lord will continue to strengthen and inspire them.

**Wed 30** – Recently FEBC reached out to the families of prisoners. Many wives of prisoners have young children who don't know their fathers because they are in jail. Pray that the Lord will sustain these families.

**Thu 31** – FEBC Cambodia's Voice of Love studio has recently undergone renovations



and installed new equipment to improve the overall quality of the broadcasts produced. Pray for the technicians that worked hard to ensure the project's success.

## September

**Fri 1** – Team members are sent out into the field to distribute radios, or speaker boxes and conduct follow-up visits on a regular basis. Please pray for their safety during their travel to these communities.

**Sat 2** – Chann Sam, an energetic and vibrant woman from Voice of Love, works as the Public Relations & Marketing officer. Pray

that the Lord will guide her in wisdom and strength so that through her work many will be reached by the gospel.

## ***FEBC Radio International Thailand***

**Sun 3 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Thai people generally have the freedom to choose their own religion, however the majority of the population practice Buddhism and it has been known that people who choose Christianity are shunned and to a certain extent forbidden in smaller remote villages by the local religious authorities. Additionally because of poverty, Thai people do not have access to Bibles or Christian literature in their own languages. FEBC has been effective in reaching out to the people of Thailand. Join us this week in prayer as we continue to call upon the Lord to uplift, transform and bless

the team and listeners in this nation.

**Mon 4** – Recently four staff members travelled to a remote part of the country, affected by the floods, to distribute 810 new radios. Pray that many people will receive salvation through FEBC's broadcasts.

**Tue 5** – Please pray for the communities and families affected by the floods this year. Pray that the Lord will bring restoration, strength and renewed hope.

**Wed 6** – Thousands of people have seen their lives transformed through our Bible Correspondence Course. Pray that the information shared will have a lasting effect on these people who will in turn lead many others to Christ.

**Thu 7** – Pray that the Lord will protect and bless the team who make regular follow-up visits to see the listeners and to inform them of any new programs that become available.

**Fri 8** — Pray for all our listeners who have joined the Bible Correspondence Course. Pray that they will impart the knowledge they receive with everyone around them for the purpose of building God's Kingdom.

**Sat 9** — A listener wrote: "Every time I listen to this program I am touched by the content and the matters you bring up." Pray that many others' lives will be transformed.

## ***FEBC's ministry to the Hmong***

**Sun 10 — WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Committed to reaching the unreached, FEBC has been using indigenous programmers for many years to reach people in their own native language. Radio is an excellent way to reach people in almost any location or circumstance, and this is exactly how we reached the Hmong, an isolated group of about five million people, living mostly in the inaccessible highlands of Laos, China, Vietnam, Thailand and Myanmar. Join us in prayer for the Hmong of Southeast Asia.

**Mon 11** — John Lee, a Hmong, left Asia for the United States. He felt called by God to start working with FEBC as a radio broadcaster to minister to his people by broadcasting into his country from afar. Praise God for the over 330 000 people who had converted to Christianity because of the FEBC broadcasts — the broadcasts that John Lee produced!

**Tue 12** — When FEBC's team first met with this Hmong community they asked them how important the radio broadcasts are to them and the village believers said that it was their source of comfort. Pray that more will find this comfort by tuning into FEBC's broadcasts.

**Wed 13** — Despite that Christians, in certain parts of Southeast Asia, were being forced to sign their names to documents, denying their faith, many Hmong Christians stood firmly by what they believe. Please pray against the persecution of these people.

**Thu 14** — The Hmong are some of the most engaged listeners at FEBC. Thank God for the responses we receive from the Hmong from across Southeast Asia.

**Fri 15** — Research has shown that 25 people are often impacted by a single radio in most rural communities, like with the Hmong. Pray for these villagers who often stop their work to listen to our broadcasts.

**Sat 16** — FEBC daily broadcasts an hour to the Hmong people - half an hour in the mornings and half an hour at night. Pray for the producers of these broadcasts, that God will inspire their program content.



# FEBC Indonesia



**Sun 17 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Indonesia is made up of more than 13 000 islands, where millions of people live in huge cities or on distant islands and deep in rain forests. Radio remains vital in penetrating these areas where people live isolated. Because radio is so critical in sharing the gospel with the people of Indonesia, we are very concerned for our station in the city of Makassar which is in danger of going off the air due to lack of funding. Please pray for FEBC Indonesia this week.

**Mon 18 –** More than R1 million is needed to keep the Makassar broadcasts on air to continue reaching a potential audience of over a million people. Please pray that God will provide these needed funds.

**Tue 19 –** Since 1998 FEBC Indonesia has developed FM stations on five islands. Please pray that FEBC will be able to develop more stations on many more of the 13 000 Indonesian islands.

**Wed 20 –** FEBC Indonesia produces programs in six minority languages and one main language from the Philippines. Please pray for the program producers and the broadcasters of FEBC Indonesia.

**Thu 21 –** Please pray for the listener follow-up through phone calls, letters, and emails and home visitations which are a mainstay of the Indonesian ministry.

**Fri 22 –** FEBC Indonesia demonstrates the love of Jesus through tangible outreach, such as medical clinics, disaster response, and many more. Please pray for this additional ministry.

**Sat 23 –** Please pray for Mo, who grew up in Iran and followed the religion of his parents. Mo knew something was wrong and today he follows Jesus and tells thousands of Iranian and Afghan Muslims about love and forgiveness through his FEBC radio program out of Indonesia.

## FEBA India

**Sun 24 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** The radio ministry in India originated in the 1950's with an in-country presence taking place in 1960 in Delhi with the participation of the Evangelical Radio Fellowship of India (ERFI) and FEBC, from Manila. In 1956, the first broadcasts in two languages were transmitted to India from FEBC Philippines. Later, a headquarters was established in Bangalore to train local personnel in radio production. Hence, a studio and office were set up in 1964 and an Indian association was formed, FEBA India. Join us this week as we pray for FEBA India's ministry.

**Mon 25** – FEBA India broadcasts in 11 Indian languages including English through short-wave and medium wave. Pray that listeners will tune in and listen to the Good News in their own languages.

**Tue 26** – FEBA India can be heard on 5 AM stations and 1 shortwave station in India and 1 shortwave station in Sri Lanka. Thank God that people from both these countries have access to the gospel broadcasts.

**Wed 27** – Please pray for the broadcasts in South India, which is broadcasted daily for one hour and 20 minutes; and also for those in North India, which is broadcasted for 30 minutes a day on SW and seven weekly programs on AM.

**Thu 28** – Program presenters follow up with listeners and those seeking to know more about Christ. Praise God for the 1 200 - 1 500 listeners who respond by phone, SMS or letters, each month.

**Fri 29** – There is a great need for the Word of God to reach the Hadothi-speaking people group in India. Pray for funds to distribute more speaker boxes, which is an excellent tool to evangelise them.

**Sat 30** – "My sister-in-law, who was contemplating suicide, heard your program and the Holy Spirit convinced her to change her mind. She became a worshiper of the true and living God." Praise God for testimonies like these!

## FEBC Japan

**October**

**Sun 1 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** While Ja-

pan's official policy on religion suggests freedom of choice, the truth is quite different. If someone belongs to a group out of the norm,





such as Christianity, he is often cut off from familial attachments. This makes FEBC's role all the more important, as we try to be both a teaching ministry and a worship service for a large number of listeners fearful of attending a church. Please keep the work of FEBC Japan in your prayers this week!

**Mon 2** – Please pray for our Japanese team who produces our broadcasts in Tokyo, which is aired daily from our Korea station, since national Japanese networks do not air religious programs.

**Tue 3** – FEBC Japan produces radio programs

from its studios in Tokyo, which means FEBC is the only Christian broadcasting company in all of Japan. Pray that the people will tune in and listen.

**Wed 4** – Japanese programs are aired 75 minutes a day from a transmitter on the island of Jeju in South Korea, which is strong enough to reach all of Japan. Thank God for the power of radio!

**Thu 5** – Daily broadcasts can be heard on FEBC Japan's website. Pray that people will also use this medium to listen to the gospel.

**Fri 6** – Pray that God will inspire their program content which is a 100% Christian. These include sermons, Bible studies, counselling programs, worship music, and testimonies.

**Sat 7** – Please pray for FEBC Japan's follow-up ministry. The ministry involves their staff visiting churches and encouraging people to tune into FEBC Japan's broadcasts.

## ***FEBA Malawi***

**Sun 8 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** "Malawi is the Israel of Africa," according to some ministers in Malawi. The Gospel was well received by the people of Malawi when missionaries first started to go there. But, FEBA Malawi focuses on reaching the unreached Yao people group of Malawi, Tanzania and Mozambique. Please pray for FEBA Malawi.

**Mon 9** – The Yao people are predominantly Muslim with only 2% estimated to be Christian and about 2 million of them are spread over these 3 countries. Please pray that the message of the gospel will touch these people's hearts.

**Tue 10** – Many Yao Muslims have been saved through FEBA's ministry in Malawi but there's still many people who need the truth of Christ. Pray for these lost souls to also be saved.

**Wed 11** – We receive hundreds of listener responses from the Yao people each month. Pray for more responses and the team who follows-up on these responses.

**Thu 12** – Please pray for FEBA Malawi's Board and their National Director, Amos Siyabu Phiri, who works hard to touch these Yao Muslim's hearts.

**Fri 13** – Amos, who is a Yao himself and was a Muslim before He got saved, not only communicates to these people in their own language, but relates to them on a cultural level. Please pray for all our ethnic broadcasters across the globe.

**Sat 14** – A Yao listener wrote, “I am glad to say that I have heard the truth about who Jesus is in my own tongue.” Pray that God will use these Yao-language broadcasts for the advantage of His Kingdom.

## ***FEBA South Africa's ministry in Mali***

**Sun 15 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** Of the 19 million people living in Mali only 450 000 are Christians. According to the Open Doors World Watch List, Mali ranks at number 32 of the world's most persecuted countries. In the midst of troubling violence and disturbance of peace, there is hope. In March this year FEBA Radio South Africa heard the great news that we received a license to start our own FEBA radio station in the South-Western region of Mali. Please pray for our work there.

**Mon 16** – We praise God for the opportunity to broadcast the Good News into Mali. Please pray for all the planning and work we still need to do before the broadcasts start.

**Tue 17** – We are glad to share that we also have permission to erect 5 relay stations elsewhere in Mali, which will broaden our reach. Please pray for the planning and building of these relay stations.

**Wed 18** – Please pray that God will provide the funds needed for the new station and its relay stations and also to keep the broadcasts on air for many years to come.

**Thu 19** – Please pray that God will send personnel, who will be the managers, producers and broadcasters of this new station. This is a major operation and we rely on your continual prayers.

**Fri 20** – Fear of persecution is widespread. Please pray for the safety of all Christians in Mali and for those who will work as the voice of hope from the FEBA station.

**Sat 21** – Pray that once we are on air, the people of Mali will tune in and listen to the good news of the gospel and that this will change their lives forever.



## ***New opportunities for FEBA Radio SA***

**Sun 22 – WEEKLY SUMMARY:** FEBA Radio South Africa was known for a long time as only a support raising office within the FEBC family. Please pray with us this week for our new ventures and the new opportunities we have in Africa, especially North Africa, and the Middle East.
