Thursday 26 October: Pray for FEBA Cambodia. The team regularly travel to meet listeners and distribute radios. Pray that the unreached people in Cambodia will welcome the Good News and be blessed with the life that is in Him.

Friday 27 October: In Laos, Christians are often cut off from their tribes. Earlier this year, some were driven out of their village. FEBA Laos broadcasts the gospel through mp3 players, shortwave radio, and Facebook Live. Pray for God's strength and protection for Lao Christians, and for more Lao people to receive Christ as Saviour.

Saturday & Sunday 28-29 October: Politeness and a good image are central to Japanese culture. This makes some people hesitant to ask questions about God or Christianity, as they fear being embarrassed. People are also reluctant to accept God's salvation due to opposition from their Buddhist families. Pray that FEBA Japan's listeners will feel safe to learn about God and share the gospel with their families.

Monday 30 October: India has seen an increase in mental illness among young people, especially students. FEBA India works hard to bring the gospel to the 95% of the population that remains unreached. Pray that more young people will find FEBA India's programs and learn about God's life-changing love.

Monday 2 October: FEBA Indonesia has started holding monthly prison worship services. Praise God for the opportunity to reach out to those who need His love, and pray that He will use the team to bring about radical change in the prisoners who attend.

Tuesday 3 October: "I'm now feeling happy and willing to talk about my experience. When I first entered jail, I suffered the most. But then I met God here, and now I have a lot of hope." (Listener from Thailand)

Wednesday 4 October: "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." (Ephesians 4:32 NIV)

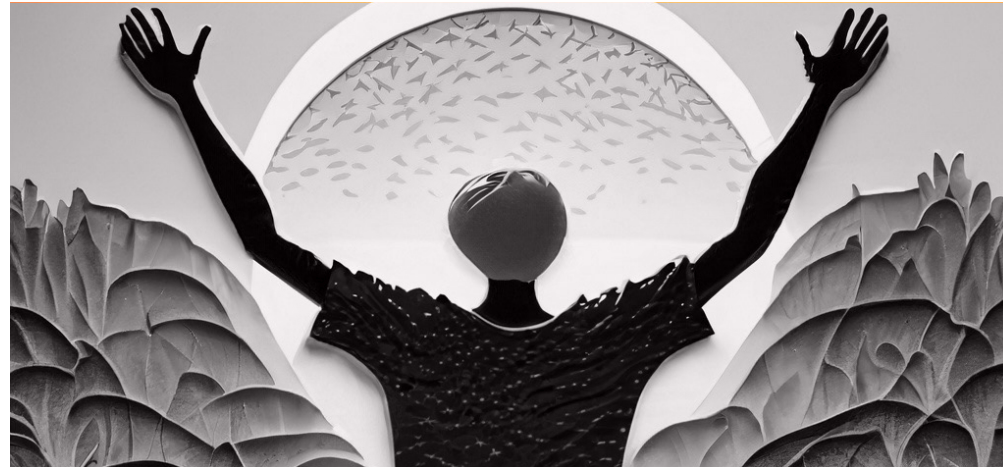
Thursday 5 October: Persecution is often motivated by misunderstanding. FEBA Pakistan holds seminars for listeners who wish to know more about the Christian faith, and attendees have testified that the truth eased their fear! Pray that FEBA Pakistan will be allowed to minister safely and that their ministry will bear much fruit.

Friday 6 October: Pray for FEBA Malawi. The team works hard to spread the Truth of Christ among their Yao listeners, travelling extensively to meet with them, distribute Bibles and establish listener clubs. Pray for the team's safety and that God will provide all they need to minister effectively.

Saturday & Sunday 7-8 October: Praise God for the millions of listeners who have heard the Good News through FEBA's radio, internet broadcasts, gospel speaker boxes, and social media ministry. No matter the country, language, culture, or challenges, we are all one in Christ. Pray that our Father will make His presence felt among His children, and give them the courage to share the truth with those they meet.

Monday 9 October: The war in Ukraine has left many devastated and feeling hopeless. FEBA Ukraine keeps reaching out to people through radio, internet, social media, and the counselling centre, to share the message of God's love and salvation. Pray that listeners will find hope and comfort in Christ.

Tuesday 10 October: "Through three years of listening to your radio programs, I know that Christianity is not superstition, but true religion. I decided to commit my life to Christ." (Listener from China)

Thursday 12 October: FEBA Kazakhstan is building a solid internet-based ministry, with videos on YouTube and TikTok that garner thousands of views – many from Muslims. Pray that God will give the team the inspiration, creativity and energy they need to share the Good News in their country.

Friday 13 October: Praise God for FEBA Mozambique Impact Radio's new tower. At 56 meters tall, it will allow the Good News to reach more people in Central Mozambique. Pray also for the FEBA Mozambique team's safety as they minister in areas where there are jihadist attacks.

Saturday & Sunday 14-15 October: The Philippines are experiencing devastating typhoons this season, with frequent floods and damage to infrastructure. FEBA has two massive shortwave stations at Iba and Bocaue that broadcast to East Asia, Russia, and Southeast Asia. Pray for the Filipino people who have lost their homes or loved ones. Pray that God will keep His hand over the stations and the FEBA Philippines team, so that the Good News can keep reaching those who need to hear it.

Monday 16 October: FEBA Indonesia has launched two websites that are specially designed to reach listeners indirectly in places with radical Islamists. Pray that the websites will be successful in spreading the truth of Christ and that FEBA Indonesia's ministry will be blessed in abundance.

Tuesday 17 October: "God is blessing us! Even as we face these unbelievable circumstances, we are now able

to minister more effectively than ever!" (Listener from Russia)

Wednesday 18 October: "When we were overwhelmed by sins, you forgave our transgressions." (Psalm 65:3 NIV)

Thursday 19 October: On Daebu Island, South Korea, there is a powerful AM radio station that reaches the entire North Korea. FEBA Korea works with defectors to create content especially for North Koreans. Thank God for this station and pray that North Koreans will hear and accept the Good News.

Friday 20 October: Pray for FEBA Chad. The radio station is moving to a new location and the team will have a new leader, as well. Praise God for the opportunities He provides and pray that the change will be smooth, so that the ministry can grow and bear fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 21-22 October: In Thailand, where Buddhism is dominant, there are more than 20,000 students taking FEBA's Bible Correspondence Course. Many of the students are in prison, and have found Christ through studying the Bible. Pray that the students will study God's Word with open hearts and minds, and that even those who are in prison will experience the freedom that is in Christ.

Monday 23 October: In Kyrgyzstan, girls are occasionally kidnapped and forced into marriage. Poverty plays a big role in this illegal practice. Some of FEBA Kyrgyzstan's female listeners are trapped in abusive marriages that were forced upon them. Pray that God will comfort them and heal their relationships through FEBA Kyrgyzstan's broadcasts.

Tuesday 24 October: "Our services and meetings take place under a tree when it is not raining. KanuYah FM Sollo has become our teacher, our pastor and our library at the same time." (Listener from Mali)
