Wednesday 24 April: "...let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith." (Hebrews 12:1-2 NIV)

**Thursday 25 April:** FEBA Ethnic Ministries broadcast to minority groups all over Southeast Asia, including the Hmong, Khmu, Shan and Mien. Hundreds of thousands of these people have given their lives to Christ because of the broadcasts. Praise God for using FEBA Ethnic Ministries to bring Christ to the world through media.

**Friday 26 April:** Did you know? After about 125 years of evangelisation, Niger is still more than 99% Muslim. FEBA Niger is building a team of young, passionate believers to share the Good News with the people of Niger. Pray that God will guide FEBA Niger as it works to create programs that touch people's hearts.

**Saturday & Sunday 27-28 April:** The southern part of Malawi is experiencing drought and faces the possibility of a reduced harvest. Yet FEBA Malawi's harvest remains bountiful: every month, Litala FM gains scores of new listeners, and numerous listener clubs are created in Yao Muslim villages in Malawi, Mozambique and Tanzania. Praise God for blessing FEBA Malawi. Pray that He will bring relief in the drought and provide food, and that people will tune in to Litala FM to learn more about the God of love and miracles.

**Monday 29 April:** Pray for believers in India, where more states are becoming openly hostile towards Christianity. Many people in India, especially young people, suffer from mental health problems like depression. Pray that they will find FEBA India's broadcasts and embrace the Good News, and that God will bring healing to the country.

**Tuesday 30 April:** "I have been blessed and comforted by your programmes, which bring me closer to God. My family listens because your programs have changed my life and helped me stand strong in God. Recently, I was excited to buy ten radios to give to new Christians and people in the church so they can also hear God's message of hope." (FEBA Cambodia listener)

Monday 1 April: FEBA China's Liangyou Bible Institute has trained thousands of pastors to share the Good News with people in China and Hong Kong. Despite harsher restrictions, the church keeps growing, and good leaders are needed. Pray that God will raise up dynamic leaders through FEBA China's training program.

**Tuesday 2 April:** "At first, I knew about God but lacked faith. Through listening to Pamalandong every morning, we're blessed. We're thankful for the good teachings from God's Word. Now, I believe in God. I've learned that we just need to trust God, and He provides what we need." (FEBA Philippines listener)

Wednesday 3 April: "For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit Himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children ..." (Romans 8:15-16 HCSB)

**Thursday 4 April:** FEBA Philippines not only shares the Good News to 65% of the Philippines in about 26 local languages, but also runs two shortwave stations that broadcast the gospel in 42 languages to listeners outside the country. Pray that God will bless the FEBA Philippines team and their work, until all have heard.

**Friday 5 April:** FEBA Sudan is making good progress, but there is a need for people who are equipped to establish the radio station. Pray that God will guide every decision, and that He will inspire skilled workers to become involved, so that FEBA Sudan can begin broadcasting the gospel as soon as possible.

**Saturday & Sunday 6-7 April:** In North Korea, most people live in fear and poverty. Defection is dangerous, due to authorities, human traffickers, and conmen. If they make it to South Korea, they are often marginalised. FEBA Korea broadcasts programs created and presented by North Korean defectors, to tell North Koreans of the God who cares about them. Letters from North Korean listeners tell of the hope they have found in Christ through FEBA Korea's programs. Pray that God will protect FEBA listeners in North Korea and enable many other North Koreans to encounter Him through radio.

**Monday 8 April:** FEBA Indonesia's children's program, Adventure in God's Kingdom, has started airing on Radio Heartline. The announcer, known as Uncle Timo, teaches children and their parents how to read the Bible and spend quiet time with God. Pray that FEBA Indonesia's program will reach many children and raise up a generation of faithful Christians.

**Tuesday 9 April:** "Thanks to KanuYah FM, I have been able to start a Bible school in Djokéli, where I now teach the Bible to 42 kids. Every day, their parents listen to KanuYah FM together with the children, and this makes my work very easy. God bless KanuYah and FEBA always! Amen." (FEBA Mali listener)

Wednesday 10 April: "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 13:34-35 NIV)

**Thursday 11 April:** FEBA Kazakhstan is not permitted to broadcast on radio in their country, but their social media ministry is growing! Thousands of Muslims watch their videos. Pray that God will help FEBA Kazakhstan to deal with those who are displeased with their success, and that He will inspire their content creation.

**Friday 12 April:** FEBA Ethiopia's broadcast reach listeners as far away as Iraq and Lebanon. They have received testimonies from people who found the program unintentionally and ended up giving their hearts to Christ. Pray that many listeners will discover the truth of God's grace through FEBA Ethiopia's programs.

**Saturday & Sunday 13-14 April:** FEBA's International Council Conference begins on Monday 15 April. Leaders from every FEBA field will gather in Seoul, South Korea, to share stories, receive training, and do strategic planning. Pray that FEBA's leaders will experience God's presence at the conference and follow His guidance in their decision-making. Pray for God to bless them with creativity in solving problems, and that they will return home safely to share His wisdom with their teams.

**Monday 15 April:** Voice of Egypt, FEBA International's online radio team, has recently gained three new staff members. Pray that they will do their work with passion and diligence, and that God will inspire them with creative ideas to draw more listeners and share the Good News with them.

**Tuesday 16 April:** "A while ago, I asked FEBA Korea to pray for my elder brother ... he lived a vain life without believing in Jesus, but miraculously accepted Jesus at the end of his life. I requested prayer so that my brother, who had little time left, could peacefully conclude his life. Thank you for your prayers." (FEBA Korea listener)

Wednesday 17 April: "Sing to the Lord, all the earth; proclaim his salvation day after day. Declare his glory among the nations, his [marvellous] deeds among all peoples." (1 Chronicles 16:23-24 NIV)

Thursday 18 April: Malaysia's constitution states that all ethnic Malays are Muslim. Therefore, if an ethnic Malay converts to Christianity, they run the risk of breaking the law. Pray that God will use FEBA Malaysia to bring about transformation in Malaysian society, including the lawmakers, so that His children can freely worship Him.

**Friday 19 April:** FEBA Mozambique runs an agricultural project that provides widows with employment and hungry people with food. God has blessed them with good harvests. Praise God for His provision and pray that FEBA Mozambique's ministry will enjoy the same success. Pray also for the team at Radio Nuru in the north, where jihadist violence prevails.

**Saturday & Sunday 20-21 April:** Did you know? Japan is sometimes referred to as a "missionaries" graveyard", because it is so difficult to spread the gospel there. Buddhism and Shintoism are so woven into society that it has become a part of Japanese culture. But God is a God of hope, so FEBA Japan has added three new programs this month and are looking into ways of using the internet to maximum effect. Pray that God will inspire FEBA Japan's creativity and draw many listeners to their programs.

Monday 22 April: In Mali, jihadist insurgency is becoming worse. Civilians, including children, suffer in the conflict between the insurgents and Mali's security forces. Pray that God will protect His children, that FEBA Mali will reach many listeners with the Good News, and that even the insurgents will encounter Christ.

**Tuesday 23 April:** "I am mostly neglected by friends and family. My soul was hurting deeply and I had lost my hope. One day, I heard the program Passion for Youth and I learned that we can turn our sorrow into joy by trusting God. I became a regular listener. The hopeful messages, encouraging counselling and loving attitude of the FEBA Pakistan team brought hope and joy into my life." (FEBA Pakistan listener)
