

**Wednesday 24 July:** “This is the kind of love we are talking about—not that we once upon a time loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they’ve done to our relationship with God.” (1 John 4:10 MSG)

**Thursday 25 July:** FEBA Thailand has launched a new series for Cambodian migrant workers. The program host, who served as a missionary in Cambodia for ten years, now teaches the migrants to speak Thai while also sharing God’s Word with them. Pray that this new project will yield a great harvest.

**Friday 26 July:** Pray for FEBA Philippines as the country enters the storm season. FEBA’s two shortwave stations at Iba and Bocaue broadcast to some of the hardest-to-reach places on earth. Pray for God’s hand of protection over the infrastructure, so that the Good News can stay on air as a source of calm in the middle of storms.

**Saturday & Sunday 27–28 July:** FEBA Kyrgyzstan’s radio station was recently voted among the top 15 stations in the country’s southern capital, Osh. As the only Christian station among the predominantly Muslim contenders, this is a huge honour! FEBA Kyrgyzstan broadcasts the Good News faithfully to listeners in urban and rural, even remote, areas. Kyrgyzstan is currently home to many troubled marriages, and men and women frequently contact FEBA for guidance. Pray that God will mend marriages and heal families through FEBA Kyrgyzstan’s broadcasts.

**Monday 29 July:** Did you know? Moldova is the least-visited country in Europe. FEBA Moldova broadcasts on five stations in the country, which has less than 5% evangelical Christians. Poverty is prevalent and many children lose their parents to alcoholism. Pray that many listeners will tune in to FEBA Moldova’s programs and learn about God’s love for them.

**Tuesday 30 July:** “My parents stayed behind, and things only got worse. Gas, electricity, and water all disappeared. In the end, the connection deteriorated, and I could only find out how they were from very short phone calls... Since I joined FEBA Ukraine, I’ve found my purpose—to bring light where darkness currently reigns. Please pray for Ukrainians to see the light of Christ through FEBA’s programs.” (FEBA Ukraine broadcaster)

**Wednesday 31 July:** “So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy.” (John 16:22 NIV)



# Prayer Focus

## July 2024

*“The Lord bless you and keep you;  
the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you;  
the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.”  
Numbers 6: 24-26 AFR20*

**Monday 1 July:** Pray for FEBA China, who must contend with new measures to block the Good News online. Millions of listeners have come to Christ through their programs, which include Bible studies and Bible dictation. Pray for doors to open so that FEBA China can continue sharing God’s Word with people online.

**Tuesday 2 July:** “It’s been five years since I discovered FEBA broadcasting. Not a day goes by that I don’t listen to it. I can endure even the toughest days because I believe that God loves me and is with me!” (FEBA Japan listener)

**Wednesday 3 July:** “For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.” (Hebrews 4:15-16 ESV)

**Thursday 4 July:** Pray for listeners in Japan. Despite its material success, the country is facing serious societal difficulties, with a declining birthrate and an increase in social recluses. Pray that FEBA Japan’s programs will reach into people’s hearts and awaken a thirst for God’s Word.

**Friday 5 July:** FEBA Hong Kong produces programs for broadcast locally and to Mainland China. It faces grave threats to religious freedom, with its websites and online channels being blocked by the government. Pray for God to grant FEBA Hong Kong wisdom and creativity as it navigates its challenges, so that the Good News can keep reaching people.

**Saturday & Sunday 6-7 July:** FEBA Mozambique is building its seventh station! Approximately 40% of adults in Mozambique are illiterate, which makes radio an ideal medium to reach them with the Good News. The FEBA Mozambique team regularly visits remote villages to meet listeners, distribute radios and other materials, and establish listener clubs. They face many challenges, especially in the north, where the conflict between jihadists and security forces is escalating. Praise God for His provision of a seventh station and pray for His blessing and protection of FEBA Mozambique and its listeners.

**Monday 8 July:** Praise God for FEBA's growing audience in Tanzania, where the Yao people can listen to FEBA Mozambique and FEBA Malawi's programs. Pastor Amos Phiri recently visited several villages in Tanzania and established 125 new listener clubs! Praise God for this opportunity and pray that many of the Yao will come to Christ through FEBA's broadcasts.

**Tuesday 9 July:** "Despite being so isolated and without a pastor, we have had the opportunity to listen to the Bible and learn much of it, so much so that we ended up adopting a Christian life without being baptised yet. We hope that one day, by the grace of God, we will have a pastor who will baptise us." (FEBA Mali listener)

**Wednesday 10 July:** "And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast." (1 Peter 5:10 NIV)

**Thursday 11 July:** In addition to the ongoing conflict within its borders, Mali now also faces tensions with its neighbours. The violence and its resulting poverty and food shortages affect many of FEBA Mali's listeners. Pray for God to intervene on His children's behalf and for their faith to remain strong in these difficult times.

**Friday 12 July:** Pray for FEBA's stations in Niger and Sudan. FEBA Niger's team is working hard to produce programs that will draw listeners to Christ, while the team in Sudan is working to get a station up and running. Praise God for the opportunity to broadcast in these countries and pray that FEBA's programs will bear great fruit.

**Saturday & Sunday 13-14 July:** FEBA has many disabled listeners around the world. People with disabilities often struggle to access the Good News and even if they do, some cannot attend church to become part of the Christian community. Radio and online broadcasts are ideal for those who are visually impaired or unable to move about freely, while teams like FEBA Vietnam produce video broadcasts for their Deaf audience. This provides the opportunity to hear God's Word and engage with other believers. Praise God for the technology that enables FEBA to reach listeners with disabilities and pray that His Word will transform their lives.

**Monday 15 July:** Today is World Youth Skills Day! FEBA Indonesia recently conducted its first day-long workshop on becoming a Chris-

tian content creator and 60 young people attended. They learned the essentials of storytelling and content writing, as well as the features of various social media channels. Pray that many young people will come to Christ through FEBA Indonesia's workshops.

**Tuesday 16 July:** "Your program had very interesting songs in my native style. They were all about God and faith and worship. I had never heard this before in my mother tongue. I want to tell you that hearing about Jesus in my language was awesome! He is now my Jesus and I walk with Him every day." (FEBA listener in Southeast Asia)

**Wednesday 17 July:** "The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners ... to comfort all who mourn ..." (Isaiah 61:1-2 NIV)

**Thursday 18 July:** Pray for FEBA's prison ministries in Eurasia and Southeast Asia. In some countries, prisoners and their families draw great comfort from FEBA's radio and online broadcasts, while in others, FEBA's teams have the privilege of conducting worship services and Bible studies in prisons. Pray that God will use FEBA to share with prisoners the Truth that sets free.

**Friday 19 July:** Pray for the countries where governments work to restrict access to the Good News, such as Russia, China, India, and North Korea. The FEBA listeners in these places accept Christ at great personal risk, while the FEBA teams face danger and challenges in sharing God's Word. Pray for their faith to be increased and their strength to be renewed each day.

**Saturday & Sunday 20-21 July:** A new conscription law in Myanmar makes it mandatory for men ages 18 to 35 and women ages 18 to 27 to enlist for military service. This means that some people must fight on behalf of their oppressors. Young Christians especially face an ethical conundrum, as they are forced to take up arms against fellow human beings. Christianity is frowned upon in the country, with militia groups targeting communities of believers to make them give up their faith. Pray for God to use FEBA Myanmar to comfort believers, bring more people to Christ, and give them peace.

**Monday 22 July:** Did you know? FEBA broadcasts to 18 ethnic minorities in their own languages and its programs have introduced millions to God's Word. The work can be tough due to extremely mountainous terrain and deep-rooted animistic traditions. Pray for God to open doors to more unreached people groups, and for FEBA Ethnic Ministries to draw strength from His presence.

**Tuesday 23 July:** "Thank you for your broadcasts. I just accepted the Lord Jesus two months ago. I am willing to die for Christ. I will do the best I can so that more people will come to know Him." (FEBA Myanmar listener)
