

**Wednesday 23 October:** "Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed," says the Lord, who has compassion on you." (Isaiah 54:10 NIV)

**Thursday 24 October:** In addition to illness among the staff and their families, FEBA Mozambique faces many difficulties in its ministry. In the north are the jihadists, and elsewhere witchcraft is a growing problem. Pray for God's hand of protection over FEBA Mozambique as they carry the Good News to the unreached in dangerous circumstances.

**Friday 25 October:** Praise God for the tremendous growth in FEBA Malawi's ministry! They have established nearly 20,000 listener clubs and receives feedback from listeners as far afield as the USA and China. Despite economic hardships, the FEBA Malawi team continues in their faithful service. Pray that God will fulfil all their needs.

**Saturday & Sunday 26-27 October:** Pray for those FEBA listeners who are elderly, ill, lonely, or overwhelmed. Many of these listeners find great comfort in FEBA's broadcasts and regularly communicate with the teams, who make an effort to respond and so build relationships. Many teams also go out of their way to visit listeners in person. Pray that listeners who are in need of companionship will find it in God's Word through FEBA's ministry, and that they will be able to share it with others who need the same.

**Monday 28 October:** KanuYah FM, FEBA Mali's radio station, draws both Christian and Muslim listeners with their excellent programs and music broadcasts. Their broadcasts have encouraged Muslims to read the Bible and turn to Christian prayer for healing. Pray that God will reveal Himself through FEBA Mali's broadcasts to the unreached in Mali.

**Tuesday 29 October:** "I [recently] received a solar light and radio/mp3 player through Krusa FM. These gifts are blessings beyond words. Now, this precious light allows me to stay active even after sunset, and the radio/mp3 player fills my home with the Word of God and songs of praise. It's like God has placed His hands over my life, reminding me of His love, even in the simplest moments." (FEBA Cambodia listener)

**Wednesday 30 October:** "Deep calls to deep in the roar of your waterfalls; all your waves and breakers have swept over me. By day the Lord directs his love, at night his song is with me— a prayer to the God of my life." (Psalm 42:7-8 NIV)

**Thursday 31 October:** Millions of people in Africa and Asia are trapped in superstitious belief systems that fill their daily lives with fear. Praise God for the opportunity to broadcast the Good News to many of these people groups and pray that they will encounter freedom in Christ when they listen to FEBA's programs.



# Prayer Focus

October 2024

*"Berge kan padgee, heuwels kan wankel,  
maar my liefde vir jou sal nooit verdwyn nie,  
my vredeverbond met jou sal nooit wankel nie,  
sê die Here, wat jou liefhet."  
(Jesaja 54:10 Afr83)*

**Tuesday 1 October:** "Over the last two years, my mother, my father, and now, my wife all died. It's just me and my ten-year-old daughter now. I feel such a weight ... I had never agreed with Christianity. I didn't think it was real ... Thank you for helping me realize that I am not alone, that God is with me. I am infinitely grateful to you!" (FEBA Ukraine listener)

**Wednesday 2 October:** "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand." (John 10:27-28 NIV)

**Thursday 3 October:** Pray for all the soldiers who listen to FEBA's broadcasts in Northeast Africa, Mozambique, Ukraine and Russia. Radio and online broadcasts can be a great comfort in tough circumstances, and the Good News offers hope amid terrible fear. Pray that every soldier who hears a FEBA broadcast will turn to Christ for peace and strength.

**Friday 4 October:** FEBA Radio SA is hosting a testimony meeting at DRC Bellville-Riebeeck on 19 October, where Dr Jurie Vermeulen will be sharing inspiring updates about FEBA's work around the world. Pray that everyone who attends will enjoy a blessed fellowship and experience God's presence at the event.

**Saturday & Sunday 5-6 October:** FEBA Ukraine has lost a third station to the war and a fourth one is in danger. The team is working hard to keep up with the growing ministry and the increasing need for God's Word. With a potential energy crisis looming as winter approaches, they and their listeners are exhausted and desperate for hope. Pray that FEBA Ukraine and their listeners will find renewed hope and courage in God's promises every day. Pray for God's provision through winter and for His peace to come between Russia and Ukraine

**Monday 7 October:** More than 28% of Kazakhstan's population are younger than 35. Many of the young people in this Muslim majority country are earnestly seeking the Truth and finding it through FEBA Kazakhstan's social media broadcasts. Pray that FEBA Kazakhstan will keep sharing God's Word boldly in the face of challenges and opposition.

**Tuesday 8 October:** "My three friends and I are soldiers, and we listen to your radio broadcasts secretly — because we are not free to listen to spiritual programs or read the Bible. Pray that, by example, we will be good witnesses for Christ." (FEBA listener in Northeast Africa)

**Wednesday 9 October:** "A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:14-16 NIV)

**Thursday 10 October:** Many believers in Laos have poor cell signal and limited internet access, so they are profoundly grateful for radio! FEBA's shortwave broadcasts reach listeners deep in the mountains and the Good News frees them from animism. Pray that believers will share FEBA Laos's broadcasts with their neighbours, so that more can come to Christ.

**Friday 11 October:** FEBA's leaders face an array of challenges, some of them common and others unique to the countries they work in. Despite professional and personal difficulties, they are resolved to lead their teams in carrying out the Great Commission, until all have heard. Pray for FEBA's leadership to walk closely with God and listen to His voice.

**Saturday & Sunday 12-13 October:** Praise God for the success of FEBA Indonesia's children's programs, which recently won multiple awards! The team has developed a new program for Christian educators and parents, teaching them how to reach children in a digital era and how to apply Christian principles in parenting. Praise God for His blessing on the FEBA Indonesia team. Pray that many parents and educators will benefit from the new program and that every child listener will get to know Christ through the children's programs.

**Monday 14 October:** Pray for those in the Philippines who were affected by Super Typhoon Carina and Tropical Storm Enteng. Severe flooding has left millions displaced. Through it all, FEBA Philippines' First Response Radio teams have been broadcasting

practical information and much-needed hope. Pray that listeners will find comfort in Christ as they rebuild their lives.

**Tuesday 15 October:** "I'm writing from the Tacloban City Jail Female Dorm. I never imagined that in prison, I would come to know God. At five in the morning, we turn on the radio and tune in to FEBA Philippines' station. Every day, we hear songs and teachings about the powerful, loving, and forgiving God who gives me hope." (FEBA Philippines listener)

**Wednesday 16 October:** "My purpose in writing is simply this: that you who believe in God's Son will know beyond the shadow of a doubt that you have eternal life, the reality and not the illusion. And how bold and free we then become in his presence, freely asking according to his will, sure that he's listening." (1 John 5:13-14 MSG)

**Thursday 17 October:** FEBA's websites and online platforms are frequently under attack from people who mean harm. This puts broadcasting at risk and makes it difficult for listeners to access the programs they need to hear. Pray for God's protection over the entire FEBA's websites and apps, so that they can keep taking Christ to the world.

**Friday 18 October:** FEBA Malaysia is experiencing an exciting time of growth, with new staff members, a new app in progress, and lots of evangelisation materials being distributed. Pray that the team's efforts will bear fruit in this Muslim majority country, where evangelising brings many challenges. Pray also for the new staff members to bring fresh ideas and energy to the ministry.

**Saturday & Sunday 19-20 October:** Alexey V., a program director for FEBA Russia, is leading efforts to establish FEBA's ministry in Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, and Tajikistan. All three of these countries are largely Muslim and present significant obstacles to evangelisation, including restrictions on proselytising and the distribution of religious literature. However, there are also opportunities for sharing the Good News and the hope it brings. Pray that God will guide Alexey and his team to the right people and places, so that FEBA can begin broadcasting God's Word to the unreached in these countries.

**Monday 21 October:** FEBA's ministry in Africa is growing! FEBA Mozambique is building its seventh station, Victoria FM, while FEBA Sudan has secured a license and currently building their station, which will broadcast the Good News across the Nuba Mountains for the first time ever. Praise God for this growth and pray for His blessing on these endeavours.

**Tuesday 22 October:** "To tell the truth, I am still a Muslim, but ... KanuYah FM Sollo often talks about prayer, [so] I sent prayer topics to our village church many times, and each time the result was just impressive. Now I would like to tell my fellow Muslims to listen carefully to KanuYah FM Sollo's Christian programs for a very positive change in their lives." (FEBA Mali listener)
