

Saturday & Sunday 23-24 November: The Bible emphasises the importance of teaching children God's Word from a young age. In today's world, young people have a lot to deal with and often feel lost and alone. FEBA broadcasts programs to teach small children about the Bible and creates social media content discussing teenage issues like peer pressure, body image, and relationships from a biblical perspective. Praise God for every child and pray that He will use FEBA to lead children and teenagers on the right path.

Monday 25 November: Young people in Kazakhstan are seeking the truth instead of blindly following tradition. Many are watching FEBA Kazakhstan's videos on social media, engaging with the team to ask questions, and even attending gatherings. Pray that FEBA Kazakhstan's content will show young people that the truth is found in God's Word.

Tuesday 26 November: "Thank you very much for taking the time to listen to me. Your advice is wonderful, as it truly helps us, especially those who have no one to turn to and no one willing to listen." (Teenage FEBA Philippines listener)

Wednesday 27 November: "Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it." (Proverbs 22:6 NIV)

Thursday 28 November: FEBA Mozambique is passionate about sharing the gospel with children and teenagers. Poverty and violent conflict push many young people into gangs, but FEBA Mozambique's youth discipleship programs have brought entire gangs to Christ! Pray that every lost child in Mozambique will find a home in God's family through FEBA's broadcasts.

Friday 29 November: Pray for the young people who form part of FEBA's Ethnic Ministry. Most of them live in extremely poor, remote mountain villages across Southeast Asia, and they battle to find hope for the future. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts will ignite hope in their hearts and show them that God has a plan for their future.

Saturday & Sunday 30 November-1 December: FEBA not only shares the Good News with listeners but also educates them in various aspects of life, from a biblical perspective. FEBA India teaches listeners to recognise the dangers of human trafficking, FEBA Pakistan hosts mental health awareness seminars, and FEBA Indonesia recently launched a radio program through which parents and educators can learn how to implement godly principles in children's education. Pray that FEBA's efforts to educate its listeners in God's Word will bear fruit and foster excellence, no matter the circumstances.



Prayer Focus

November 2024

Friday 1 November: Pray for FEBA's teams in Ukraine and Russia. Both groups share the Good News in dangerous circumstances and deal with listeners who are in crisis. Pray that God will watch over the members and families of FEBA Russia and FEBA Ukraine, and give them the necessary strength to keep broadcasting every day.

Saturday & Sunday 2-3 November: Did you know that one in every two people will probably experience a mental health problem in their lifetime? Mental health is vital to a healthy community. FEBA teams all over the world receive feedback from listeners, both old and young, who have found hope in the Good News through FEBA's programs. However, many FEBA broadcasters and counsellors suffer personal setbacks of their own. Pray that God will guard the hearts and minds of FEBA staff and listeners in all circumstances.

Monday 4 November: Suicide is on the rise among teenagers in Ukraine. FEBA Ukraine reaches out to them through social media content and meetings, where they discuss their fears and losses and seek advice. Pray that the young people in Ukraine will find hope in God's Word and strength in His presence.

Tuesday 5 November: "When I came home from the war, it felt like I was carrying the weight of the world. You told me that there was only one thing that could fill the emptiness in my soul. You woke up that desire for God in me again. Hearing you read the Bible...it really moved me...I want to read the Bible for myself." (FEBA Ukraine listener)

Wednesday 6 November: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God." (2 Corinthians 1: 3-4 NIV)

Thursday 7 November: Young people in India are experiencing a mental health crisis due to academic and work pressure. India's society is highly performance driven, which leads to burnout and toxicity in the workplace. Pray that listeners will find peace in God's presence through FEBA India's programs on radio and social media.

Friday 8 November: FEBA Chad is facing many challenges in getting the radio station back on air. Despite the numerous setbacks, the team continues to work hard and trust in God. Pray that God will smooth the way and open doors, so that FEBA Chad can start broadcasting at full capacity once more.

Saturday & Sunday 9-10 November: A happy family is a gift that will keep on giving. That is why FEBA is passionate about helping people to build relationships with strong biblical foundations, be it through radio or online programs, or family seminars. One attendee says, "I received a lot of knowledge about raising kids, forgiving others, and the life of families. My spouse and I have decided to improve by implementing God's Word and allowing Him to correct our weaknesses." Pray that God will use FEBA to raise strong families that are rooted in His Word.

Monday 11 November: FEBA Cambodia hosts family seminars in various parts of the country, where they teach married couples and parents how to build a happy family life according to God's Word. Pray that listeners will apply what they learn from FEBA Cambodia and that God will heal the broken families there.

Tuesday 12 November: "I shared with you two years ago, that I was experiencing extreme difficulties in my married life. I kept listening to your programs and strived to do what you taught. Today, my relationship with my husband is much better than before, and we pray together. I'm grateful to God that He saved and helped my family." (FEBA China listener)

Wednesday 13 November: "Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they have not seen." (1 John 4:20 NIV)

Thursday 14 November: Families in Malawi face many challenges due to poverty, different beliefs, and poor communication. FEBA Malawi addresses these issues in its Focus on the Family program, which has helped many couples and families to reconcile. Pray that FEBA Malawi will continue to teach listeners to love one another as God loves them.

Friday 15 November: Kyrgyzstan, a country that is about 90% Muslim, has a growing number of broken homes. Many women and children suffer abuse in the home, and children grow up without a concept of healthy relationships. Pray that FEBA Kyrgyzstan's programs will touch families' hearts and change their minds through God's Word.

Saturday & Sunday 16-17 November: Did you know? In 2023, the World Health Organisation declared loneliness a global health threat. People all over the world long to belong. FEBA helps millions to become part of God's family by sharing the Good News on radio, through social media, and in person. Follow-up teams stay in touch with listeners and visit them, while many also put listeners in contact with local churches where they can join fellow believers in worship. Pray that listeners will experience the joy of community through FEBA's ministry.

Monday 18 November: An estimated 40,000 people in Japan died alone at home in the first half of this year. Loneliness is a huge problem among old and young, due to a lack of work-life balance, cultural factors, and an ageing population. Pray that FEBA Japan's programs will allow lonely listeners to experience God's love and friendship.

Tuesday 19 November: "I would like to thank God for your visit ... I have received Jesus Christ as my Lord and I can now freely tell you that Christianity has given us salvation through Litala FM here in Salima. For many years, many of us have seen Christianity as a threat." (FEBA Malawi listener)

Wednesday 20 November: "Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves." (Romans 12: 9-10 NIV)

Thursday 21 November: Being a Christian in a majority Muslim country can be lonely. FEBA Niger is working hard to share the Good News with its listeners and to encourage believers, especially young people. Pray that FEBA Niger's broadcasts will create a sense of community among its listeners and draw non-believers to God's Word.

Friday 22 November: South Korea is one of the loneliest countries in the world. Young people are isolating themselves and old people lack companionship. FEBA Korea's programs broadcast across 13 stations and have brought solace to countless listeners. Pray that lonely South Koreans will tune in to FEBA's broadcasts and experience the joy of God's friendship.
