Wednesday 25 December: "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:14 NIV)

Thursday 26 December: Every day, FEBA Ukraine's counsellors and follow-up workers listen to heartbreaking stories and face tough questions. It often leaves them exhausted, especially as there is no end in sight. Pray that God will give them sufficient strength for each day and let them witness His grace at work in the darkest times.

Friday 27 December: Ukraine's infrastructure has been devastated by the war, leaving parts of the country especially vulnerable during winter. Pray for God's provision throughout the cold season and pray that He will replace each FEBA team member and listener's fear with His peace, which cannot be shaken. Pray for an end to the war.

Saturday & Sunday 28–29 December: This week, as we enter the new year, pray that God will revive His church in the countries where FEBA broadcasts. More than a third of the world's population still need to hear God's Word and many are seeking Him in all the wrong places. FEBA's broadcasts reach listeners in their cars, in their rooms, even at the hairdresser's! Pray that God will provide the necessary resources and use each FEBA broadcast in this coming year to bring in the harvest.

Melationships were mended, illnesses were healed, and many received the precious gift of the gospel. Pray for God's continued blessing next year, as FEBA carries out its mission of taking Christ to the unreached world through media, until all have heard.

Tuesday 31 December: "I used to be a big drinker who didn't value my family. However, I have noticed many changes since accepting God into my life through my pastor and Krusa FM. I quit drinking and made a commitment to live according to the Word, to love God and my family. I am free from my previous life's pain and suffering because God has healed me." (FEBA Cambodia listener)

Monday 2 December: Many FEBA listeners suffer from chronic illnesses that keep them bed- or housebound, with only media for company. Those in poorer areas also do not have access to proper healthcare. Pray for God to sustain them on their sickbeds and pray that FEBA's broadcasts will strengthen them when they become discouraged.

Tuesday 3 December: "I still believe that I will be healed, as I always hear on the broadcast of Radio Heartline Lampung that the Lord Jesus is the Physician of all physicians. At least it makes me sleep peacefully at night. Jesus did it for me." (FEBA Indonesia listener)

Wednesday 4 December: "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." (Psalm 23:1-4 NIV)

Thursday 5 December: When listeners reach out to FEBA teams in response to programs, FEBA's follow-up workers are the hands that reach back. They build relationships, pray with listeners, visit the ill and lonely, and put new believers in touch with local churches. Pray for God to bless FEBA's follow-up workers and touch people's hearts through their ministry.

Friday 6 December: Praise God for three new radio stations in Mongolia! The Mongolian church has grown exponentially in the past 30 years. Today, FEBA Mongolia shares the Good News with listeners all over the country, from those in urban areas to nomadic herdsmen on the steppes. Pray that God will bless the new stations with abundant fruit.

Caturday & Sunday 7-8 December: In China, people are hungry for hope. Soaring unemployment rates and economic difficulties are causing many to turn to Buddhist deities for help. This despair also takes its toll on families and divorce is increasingly commonplace. FEBA China has established a family ministry to address this need, with programs that teach parents how to do daily devotions with their children, and podcasts that teach couples how to have a Christ-centred marriage. Pray that FEBA China's family ministry will bring healing to families all over the country.

Monday 9 December: Did you know that some organisations use balloons to send radios into North Korea so that people may hear the Good News? North Korean believers have been persecuted for decades and fear keeps many hearts closed to the Truth. Pray that God will comfort FEBA's listeners in North Korea and bring transformation in the country.

Tuesday 10 December: "When we gather to listen to your broadcasts, we are encouraged and filled with hope. However, at the same time, we grieve because of the threat many of us face for our beliefs and because it causes countless people to not come to salvation." (FEBA Yemen listener)

Wednesday 11 December: "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. As Scripture says, 'Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.'" (Romans 10:9-11 NIV)

Thursday 12 December: FEBA Japan is working hard to expand its team and ministry. Most people in Japan have never heard the gospel and have misconceptions about Christianity. Pray that God will bless FEBA Japan's efforts and infuse every broadcast with His power, so that the Good News can spread throughout the country, until all have heard.

Eriday 13 December: There is a great yearning for salvation in ■ Taiwan, but people seek it from false gods. FEBA Taiwan broadcasts a program, Manna in the Wilderness, in multiple local languages to lead as many listeners as possible to Christ. Pray that those who listen to FEBA Taiwan's program will discover the true Source of salvation.

Saturday & Sunday 14–15 December: Praise God for giving FEBA the opportunity to start broadcasting in Niger this year. Thank Him for protecting all the FEBA Africa stations and for opening a door to Sudan. Each station faces its own unique challenges. Pray that God will grant each FEBA director in Africa wisdom to guide his team in their ministry. Pray also that those who work for FEBA will stay healthy and ask that every broadcast will carry the Good News of His love to those who need to hear it.

Monday 16 December: As South Africans celebrate the Day of **IV** Reconciliation today, pray for all the FEBA staff and listeners who deal with conflict in their daily lives, be it physical violence or strained family relationships. Pray that God will bless them with peace and that they will learn of His love through FEBA's broadcasts.

Tuesday 17 December: "I accepted Jesus as my personal Saviour through your teaching about God's love in the Hmong language. I want you to pray for me to serve God in my area." (FEBA listener in Southeast Asia)

A / ednesday 18 December: "For as high as the heavens are above **WW** the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him ..." (Psalm 103:11-13 NIV)

Thursday 19 December: The mountain villages in Laos, Thailand, and Vietnam are difficult to access, but all of them have access to FEBA's online broadcasts, which share the Good News in their own languages. Pray that God will use FEBA to touch the hearts of listeners in those villages and free them from the chains of animism.

Triday 20 December: Praise God for the success of FEBA Philippines' ■ outreaches and campaigns this year. Thank Him for protecting the radio stations during a destructive typhoon season. Pray for His continued blessing on the FEBA Philippines' team and leadership, and that they will remain passionate and faithful to His Word.

Caturday & Sunday 21-22 December: As we celebrate Christmas this Tweek, let us pray for listeners across the world to discover the true meaning of God's love and Christ's sacrifice. Pray for FEBA's teams all over the world who share the Good News every day, despite persecution, conflict, fear and grief. Pray for God to fill their hearts with joy and to give them His peace, which transcends all understanding, that they may shine the Light into the darkness and draw lost souls to its safety.

Monday 23 December: Pray for the leaders of FEBA Russia and FEBA Ukraine. Each director must lead his team through dangerous waters during these times of war and internal political tension. Pray for God's wisdom and Spirit to fill the directors of FEBA Ukraine and Russia, so that they can guide their teams in accordance with His will.

Tuesday 24 December: "We stand here as fragile vessels, **I** entrusted with the most profound message: God made us and loves us. He knows what we're going through. He has forgiven us for our sins and given us Jesus. Come to Him all you who are weary and heavy laden. Turn to Jesus." (Eduard, FEBA Ukraine director)
