

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



FEBRUARY 2025

Saturday & Sunday 1-2 February: From political turmoil to tropical storms, Mozambique has suffered one disaster after the other in recent months. In the north, FEBA's team must contend with jihadists, and several FEBA radio stations were hit by cyclones in December. Nevertheless, God has protected FEBA's team and radio stations in a miraculous way. Moreover, FEBA Mozambique's seventh station will soon be on air! Pray for God's continuous protection on FEBA Mozambique, so that His Word can keep bringing hope to listeners in times of fear.

Monday 3 February: Praise God for the listeners in Niger who are giving their lives to Christ! Many of them have been rejected by their families and left without means to look after themselves. Pray that they will stand firm in their faith as they experience God's love and provision, and that God will heal their family relationships.

Tuesday 4 February: "I was suffering in my heart, because Allah wasn't answering my prayers. While listening to the radio, I heard preaching in my dialect, talking about 'hope in Jesus'. I decided to phone the presenter and he answered my questions. That's how I became a Christian and now I'm very happy. However, if my family find out, they'll reject me, so I keep it secret. Please pray for me." (FEBA listener in Niger)

Wednesday 5 February: "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom. Relent, Lord! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants. Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days." (Psalm 90:12-14 NIV)

Thursday 6 February: Pray for the FEBA team in Chad as they resume full-time broadcasting. Poverty, violence, and food shortage are rife throughout the country, and its people need hope. Pray that the seeds of FEBA Chad's broadcasts will land in fertile soil, and that God's Word will transform those who hear it.

Friday 7 February: Praise God for the wonderful work He is doing in Malawi and Mali! Despite many challenges, both FEBA teams never grow weary of doing good, and their work inspires thousands to come to Christ. Pray that God will keep His Word on air in Malawi and Mali, until all have heard.

Saturday & Sunday 8-9 February: Pray for FEBA's ministry to Muslim populations in Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan. These countries are traditionally and predominantly Islamic, so there is fierce opposition to the gospel, and those who turn to Christ face rejection and abuse from their families and communities. Yet many are searching for the true God. Pray that God will strengthen His children's faith during hard times and that FEBA's broadcasts will lead every listener to a deeper understanding of God's Word.

Monday 10 February: Pray for FEBA Ukraine's staff members who are undergoing treatment for serious illnesses, and those whose loved ones have been injured in the war. Pray that they will draw closer to God in their difficulties and be so filled with His grace and peace that their testimonies bring others to Christ.

Tuesday 11 February: "Thank you for being with me during the darkest time of my life. I am in a much better place. Thank you for sharing God's love with me. Now I know that He is always with me." (Teenage FEBA listener in Ukraine, who contacted the counselling helpline after a failed suicide attempt)

Wednesday 12 February: "For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:38-39 NIV)

Thursday 13 February: FEBA Moldova's youth ministry is bringing hope to children and teenagers in a country where alcoholism, abuse and neglect are common. The team shares the Good News through children's programs and gatherings, where teenagers discuss their problems. Pray that Moldova's youth will find their place in God's family and their strength in Christ.

Friday 14 February: In Russia, believers who speak out against the Ukrainian war are often arrested. Broadcasters are also scrutinised for signs that they are anti-government. Pray for God to protect FEBA Russia, as He gives them the courage to proclaim the gospel boldly. Pray that their work will bear abundant fruit throughout Russia.

Saturday & Sunday 15-16 February: Even though there have been missionaries in Thailand for approximately 200 years, less than 1% of the population is Christian. FEBA Thailand has partnered with other Christian organisations in the "Love Thailand 1-1-1" project – praying and working for a harvest of 1 million believers, 10,000 churches, and 10,000 pastors by 2028. Praise God for this huge vision and for providing the partnerships to make it happen. Pray that He will fuel the project with His grace and power, and that the result will exceed the target.

Monday 17 February: In January, the Philippines' national meteorological services issued a warning that heavy rainfall may persist until March, leading to floods and landslides. Pray for people in the affected areas and for FEBA Philippines' First Response Radio teams, as they enter these areas to broadcast the Good News along with practical information.

Tuesday 18 February: "I'm a non-Christian. I was blinded in a work accident and have not worked since. In recent weeks, I've been calling Heartline Radio to ask for prayer. I was very happy to be welcomed so warmly. My mother was touched by the attention of the Heartline team, who not only prayed over the phone but also came to my house to pray for us." (FEBA listener in Indonesia)

Wednesday 19 February: "The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing." (Zephaniah 3:17 NIV)

Thursday 20 February: FEBA Cambodia forms part of the Cambodian Community Bible Institute, which conducts Bible courses in Cambodian villages. A total of 442 students participated in lessons across 21 provinces during 2024. Pray that these students will share God's Word with others, and that FEBA Cambodia and the Cambodian Community Bible Institute will draw many more students in 2025.

Friday 21 February: Political turmoil in Myanmar makes it challenging to share the Good News there. FEBA Myanmar has faithfully carried God's Word to people in remote villages for decades, where families have turned to Christ. Pray that God will give His children wisdom and peace in times of conflict. Pray also for the transition of leadership in Myanmar.

Saturday & Sunday 22-23 February: The gospel has been facing fierce opposition in parts of India, with extremists assaulting Christians and demonstrating outside churches. Despite this, FEBA India continues to share the Good News of God's love and peace with its listeners through radio and creates social media content to address issues such as relationships and mental health. Pray that the believers in India will remain firm in their faith despite persecution and that God will renew people's minds through FEBA India's programs.

Monday 24 February: FEBA Pakistan has been bringing Christ to Pakistan through media for 50 years, and despite challenging circumstances, it is still going strong. Pray for Saleem Shahzad, FEBA Pakistan's director, as he leads his team in sharing God's Word. Pray also that FEBA Pakistan's programs will speak to listeners' hearts.

Tuesday 25 February: "FEBA Radio not only inspires its listeners but also sets a benchmark in broadcasting excellence. Its dedicated efforts and outstanding services transform lives and bring hope, wisdom, and joy to people like me who can feel the hands of our Lord upon me and my family every day." (FEBA listener in Pakistan)

Wednesday 26 February: "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything." (James 1:2-4 NIV)

Thursday 27 February: Pray for FEBA teams who work in challenging environments, where they must travel dangerous routes to visit listeners, or face frequent opposition to God's Word from authorities and communities. Pray that they will never grow weary of doing good but will look to God for strength and guidance.

Friday 28 February: Radio broadcasts rely heavily on infrastructure – towers, transmitters, and studio equipment. Natural disasters can cause terrible damage, causing broadcasts to stop for hours or days at a time. Pray for God's protection over every FEBA radio station's infrastructure, so that the Good News can keep broadcasting at full strength, until all have heard.
