

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



MARCH 2025

Saturday & Sunday 1-2 March: After three years of war, doubt and despair are growing in Ukraine. People are exhausted, questioning God's existence and love, and wondering if peace will ever come. People's hearts are ready to receive the Good News, and many are contacting FEBA Ukraine in search of it. Pray for FEBA Ukraine's team members who faithfully continue to work despite their own fear and exhaustion. Pray that God will keep the fire of their faith burning, so that its light can draw lost people to Him.

Monday 3 March: Eight of FEBA Ukraine's staff members are currently serving in the military – three as chaplains and five as soldiers. They all have families waiting at home. Praise God for protecting them so far and pray for His strength to sustain them whenever fear and grief make them feel weak.

Tuesday 4 March: "Could you send me a Bible? I want to find out more. I used to be a devoted Muslim, and even a minister in a mosque. But after a while, I realised there was no truth there, so I turned away from Islam. Now I am looking for the true path." (FEBA viewer from Kazakhstan)

Wednesday 5 March: "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' ... That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong." (2 Corinthians 12:9-10 NIV)

Thursday 6 March: A new law in Kyrgyzstan is placing heavy restrictions on religious activity. Pray for God's wisdom as the FEBA Kyrgyzstan team navigates this new challenge, and pray that He will soften people's hearts so that they will receive God's Word and be transformed by the Good News.

Friday 7 March: Pray for FEBA's new ministry in Uzbekistan, a Muslim-majority country where the gospel is needed, but unwelcome. Believers frequently deal with being on the receiving end of surveillance and physical abuse. Pray that God will strengthen the team's faith and use their broadcasts to reach listeners whose hearts are ready to receive the Good News.

Saturday & Sunday 8-9 March: The 8th of March is International Women's Day. Let us lift up the women in FEBA's ministry in prayer. Some female listeners are trapped in abusive relationships or overwhelmed by motherhood, while others are praying for their sons' and husbands' safe return from the frontlines. FEBA's female staff connect with these listeners through shared experiences, serving as living examples of God's transformative love. Pray that FEBA's female staff will draw strength from God's presence as they minister to listeners and that listeners will discover joy in Christ.

Monday 10 March: Praise God for the opportunity to reach Chinese listeners in Indonesia! A selection of FEBA China's programs began airing on four of FEBA Indonesia's radio stations this year. Pray that these programs will draw many Chinese-speaking listeners and inspire them to seek God more earnestly.

Tuesday 11 March: "Through listening to your program, I learned a lot. I now know what to do that is pleasing in God's sight. This has changed me personally and, as a result, there is harmony in the family, even between me and my mother-in-law. Truly profitable. Jesus loves you all. May God bless and remember you." (FEBA listener in China)

Wednesday 12 March: "But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." (Luke 6:27-28 NIV)

Thursday 13 March: FEBA Indonesia recently started broadcasting a new program which explores the lives of Christians who live in areas that implement Sharia law. The team hopes to foster understanding and harmony. Pray that this program will encourage believers to walk closely with God through challenging circumstances and inspire non-believers to embrace the Good News.

Friday 14 March: In Japan, many view Christianity as a foreign religion and strict social rules can also make it difficult to discuss it in everyday conversation. Yet Japan is desperately hungry for the gospel. Pray that FEBA Japan will find creative and compelling ways to share the Good News with its listeners.

Saturday & Sunday 15-16 March: Praise God for FEBA Mozambique's seventh station, Victory FM, which is now broadcasting in the Cuamba region! Programs cover a wide array of topics in eight languages, including family life, spiritual leadership, Bible study, and children's programs. Pray that God will give the Victory FM team wisdom, strength, and creativity as they minister to new listeners and that He will lend His power to every broadcast, so that it will reach those who need to hear it.

Monday 17 March: Pray for FEBA Malawi's listener clubs in Machinga, Mangochi, Blantyre, and other areas affected by the food shortage crisis. Food has become extremely expensive and poverty-stricken villagers cannot afford it. Pray that FEBA Malawi's listeners will put their trust in God's provision and that their faith will be strengthened by it.

Tuesday 18 March: "I am a radio mechanic from Guinea. KanuYah FM Sollo saved me from failure and death or prison. I was a drug addict, a womaniser and a troublemaker. Thanks to KanuYah FM's sermons in Bambara and French, I now have a new life after repenting and turning to God." (FEBA listener in Mali)

Wednesday 19 March: "Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ..." (Colossians 4:2-3 NIV)

Thursday 20 March: Today is French Language Day! FEBA broadcasts French programs in Mali, Chad, and Niger, where most of the population is Muslim and the literacy rate tends to be low. Pray for God's blessing on FEBA's teams in these countries and pray for the necessary resources to give more people access to the Good News.

Friday 21 March: As we celebrate Human Rights Day in South Africa, let us pray for all the FEBA listeners worldwide who do not enjoy the same freedom as we do. Poverty, dictatorship, religious persecution, and domestic abuse all limit people's access to God's Word. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts will give these listeners a deeper understanding of God's love for them.

Saturday & Sunday 22-23 March: Starting this month, FEBA Pakistan's daily medium-wave broadcasting slot will increase from 30 minutes to 60 minutes! The team is also working on a new video series, "Christian Family Life", which they hope to launch on YouTube in April. Meanwhile, FEBA Pakistan's follow-up workers have expanded their efforts across all broadcasting platforms, seeking to engage with those who seek God and to disciple new believers. Pray that FEBA Pakistan's staff will remain safe and that their new programs will bear abundant fruit.

Monday 24 March: Across India, persecution of Christians is on the rise. Attacks range from physical violence to discrimination in the workplace. Pray for God's protection on FEBA India's staff and listeners, and pray that FEBA India's programs on radio and social media will serve as a voice of peace and comfort.

Tuesday 25 March: "My family gathers to listen to this program together. It's not just a source of learning but a moment that brings us closer as a family. Our discussions afterward inspire us to grow morally and spiritually, deepening our bond with one another. Thank you, FEBA, for creating these meaningful moments." (FEBA listener in Pakistan)

Wednesday 26 March: "And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ - to the glory and praise of God." (Philippians 1:9-11 NIV)

Thursday 27 March: Pray for FEBA's partner who broadcasts the Good News to listeners in Iraq, where Christians make up only 0.3% of the population. Iraq FM broadcasts more than 20 programs (including FEBA's) per week and receives approximately 50 phone calls per day. Pray that God will protect the staff and touch listeners' hearts through these broadcasts.

Friday 28 March: FEBA's programs can be heard in parts of South Asia and the Middle East, but the vast majority of people in these regions are still unreached. Pray for doors to open into countries where FEBA's broadcasts are most needed, and pray that those broadcasts that can currently be heard, will bear good fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 29-30 March: FEBA's ministry relies heavily on its human and material resources. Be it the leaders who strategise, the technical experts who build and maintain radio stations, the creative minds who develop radio and online content, the presenters who share that content in an engaging way, or the follow-up workers who serve as the hands that reach out to listeners in a practical way - each position is vital to FEBA's mission. Pray for FEBA workers all over the world and pray that God will bring the right people to every team.

Monday 31 March: FEBA Radio South Africa not only supports radio stations in Chad, Malawi, Mali, Mozambique, and Niger - it also helps to fund projects in Pakistan and Cambodia. Pray that God will give the FEBA Radio SA staff the necessary strength and wisdom to keep the Good News broadcasting across Africa, until all have heard.
