

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



APRIL 2025

Tuesday 1 April: "The good lessons we hear really help me and my family, teaching us values and good behaviour. I am also able to pass these lessons on to my children and family" (FEBA listener in the Philippines)

Wednesday 2 April: "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, 'Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29 NIV)

Thursday 3 April: FEBA Cambodia recently conducted a survey with more than 100 young people to determine their topics of interest. The results pointed to a need for programs that help with personal growth, decision-making, and planning for the future. Pray for God's inspiration and wisdom as FEBA Cambodia creates fresh content to draw young people to Him.

Friday 4 April: FEBA Thailand has a huge mission: to win 1 million souls for God's Kingdom by 2028! The team helps to train church leaders and distributes radios and other media to share the gospel with rural communities. Join the project by taking one minute to pray for one Thai person to come to Christ.

Saturday & Sunday 5-6 April: While Christianity is tolerated in Malawi, believers suffer severe persecution in certain rural areas where Islam is the dominant religion. FEBA listeners are beaten, kicked out of their villages, and must sometimes watch as their homes are destroyed. The country is also gripped by severe food shortages. Despite the hardships, FEBA Malawi faithfully carries out the Great Commission, travelling to remote villages to encourage believers and distribute radios, audio Bibles, Bibles, and occasionally food. Pray for FEBA Malawi as they minister to persecuted listeners and hungry souls.

Monday 7 April: FEBA Chad is back on air with a new station, RACE FM! However, the station is being targeted by vandals. Pray that God will use FEBA Chad's programs to change listeners' hearts, and that He will protect the staff and station so that they can keep broadcasting until all in Chad have heard the gospel.

Tuesday 8 April: "I almost never miss a sermon on KanuYah FM. As a Muslim, I marvel at how all year round, different pastors preach without a single contradiction, no matter the topics or themes they choose. This is never the case in my current religion." (FEBA listener from Mali)

Wednesday 9 April: "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you." (John 13:14-15 NIV)

Thursday 10 April: Islam is the dominant religion in Mali, yet FEBA's radio station is drawing more listeners by the day. The team regularly receives testimonies of healing, as well as questions from non-believers. Praise God for FEBA's growing ministry in Mali and pray for His continued blessing on FEBA Mali's staff and listeners.

Friday 11 April: It is exceptionally challenging to be a Christian in Niger, where more than 99% of the population follow Islam. Many new believers face harsh treatment from their families and communities. Some are left without homes or an income. Pray for wisdom as FEBA Niger ministers to the unreached and pray that listeners will experience His grace.

Saturday & Sunday 12-13 April: A law has been passed in Kyrgyzstan that makes it more challenging to share the gospel. The culture is governed by a harsh form of Islam. New believers often hide their faith from their spouse, parents, or family for fear of rejection or physical abuse. FEBA Kyrgyzstan's presenters and follow-up workers engage with every listener who contacts them, thus building strong relationships that lead those listeners to Christ. Pray for the FEBA Kyrgyzstan team to draw near to God in trying times and shine His light in the darkness.

Monday 14 April: FEBA Ukraine has a growing ministry for women, with programs aimed at women whose partners or fathers are in the army, as well as Bible study groups and gatherings for women who wish to learn about Christ. Pray for Emma and Inna, who run this ministry, and pray that the women who seek God will find Him.

Tuesday 15 April: "I almost became a drug addict after my mother died. I didn't have any friends, no family I could talk to. I felt like a robot. Except when I heard your broadcasts... through them, God breathes life and strength into my soul." (FEBA listener from Russia)

Wednesday 16 April: "When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly. 'He himself bore our sins' in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; 'by his wounds you have been healed.'" (1 Peter 2:23-24 NIV)

Thursday 17 April: Young listeners throughout Russia are expressing an interest in "becoming friends" with Jesus, thanks to FEBA Russia's children's programs. As a result, some parents are also beginning to open their hearts to God's Word. Praise God that these seeds have fallen on fertile ground and pray that He will make them grow and bear fruit.

Friday 18 April: "When he had received the drink, Jesus said, 'It is finished.' With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit" (John 19:30 NIV). Praise God for sending His Son as sacrifice for our sins. Pray that FEBA will continue to bring Christ to the world through media, until all have heard.

Saturday & Sunday 19-20 April: Praise God for raising Christ from the dead and thus giving us an unshakable foundation for our faith. FEBA proclaims this Good News in more than 50 countries, through radio and digital media. Pray for the staff, many of whom work in difficult professional or personal circumstances, that they will keep their eyes on Christ throughout life's storms. Pray also for the listeners, especially those who have not yet accepted the gospel, that they will open their hearts to the Risen Christ.

Monday 21 April: As we celebrate Family Day in South Africa, let us pray for families torn apart by violence, neglect or alcohol abuse in Moldova, Ukraine, and Russia. FEBA broadcasts in all three countries – programs about biblical family values, marriage, parenthood, and addiction. Pray that God will heal marriages and families through FEBA's programs.

Tuesday 22 April: "I have been listening to Krusa FM's Comfort at Night program, and it has truly helped me grow in patience and emotional resilience ... Through this program, I have transformed my mindset, choosing joy over frustration, which has greatly improved my relationship with my husband ... Thank you, Krusa FM, for this wonderful program for women." (FEBA listener in Cambodia)

Wednesday 23 April: "The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said." (Matt. 28:5-6 NIV)

Thursday 24 April: FEBA Indonesia recently conducted training with a group of young believers in an area that implements Sharia law. The training aimed to equip young Christians with the principles of evangelism and communication techniques, and to encourage them to maintain their faith in difficult circumstances. Pray that these young believers will bring many others to Christ.

Friday 25 April: Although Christians are a minority in Myanmar, many stand firm in their faith and listen to FEBA's shortwave broadcasts. FEBA is now working on programs in two new languages for listeners in Myanmar. Pray for God's guidance as the team produces these programs and pray that He will prepare listeners' hearts to receive the gospel.

Saturday & Sunday 26-27 April: Freedom is a privilege denied to many believers. Government restrictions, social pressure, and the threat of persecution prevent them from openly living and proclaiming their faith. To these believers, radio and online broadcasting are lifelines of encouragement and connection. Each FEBA team ministers to people from their own people group, so they can convey the Good News in terms the listeners understand and discuss issues they are intimately familiar with. Praise God for media and pray that FEBA will keep sharing the gospel despite limited freedom.

Monday 28 April: Praise God for opening new doors to engage with listeners in Pakistan. Pray for God's wisdom as FEBA Pakistan's leadership navigates legal requirements to ensure FEBA's continued presence in the country. Ask that He will also inspire teams as they create radio and digital content that touches hearts with the Good News.

Tuesday 29 April: "Hallelujah! My scan came back clean of cancer. Jesus has completely taken it away. I'm so humbled by His love and favour. I wanted to thank you for praying for me. I am overwhelmed by His goodness and faithfulness. God bless you, FEBA family. I am praying that God will meet you all at your greatest need." (FEBA listener from India)
