

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



MAY 2025

Thursday 1 May: “Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart ...” (Col. 3:23 NIV). FEBA works in many different cultures and circumstances, but its staff always strive to give their best in service to the gospel. Pray that God will guide FEBA’s staff in their ministry and that each one will walk closely with Him.

Friday 2 May: Godly leadership is essential to FEBA’s mission. FEBA’s Leadership Academy focuses on training and preparing future leaders to carry on the ministry with excellence in a changing world. Pray that FEBA’s current leadership will identify the right successors, and that God will raise up strong leaders for the future.

Saturday & Sunday 3-4 May: As in many countries in Africa, poverty and illiteracy are huge challenges in Chad. This makes radio an ideal medium to proclaim the gospel. FEBA Chad’s new station, RACE FM, broadcasts an array of faith-based programs in N’Djamena and surrounds, including a prayer program and Bible teaching. The station has suffered attempts at sabotage and vandalism, and some are actively trying to discourage FEBA’s work. Pray that God will protect the station and guide FEBA Chad’s team in creating content that draws listeners to Him.

Monday 5 May: Pray for FEBA Mozambique. Its seven radio stations broadcast the gospel to millions of people who have no hope in their daily lives. Poverty, hunger, violence, and political turmoil hold them trapped in fear. Pray that FEBA Mozambique’s programs will fill listeners’ hearts with the hope and peace that are found in Christ.

Tuesday 6 May: “I thank God for FEBA, for the great work of radio ministry. In a short period of time, radio has changed my life. I used to have a problem with alcohol – my whole salary was used for beer. I thank God for changing my life.” (FEBA listener in Mozambique)

Wednesday 7 May: “Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.” (Jeremiah 29:12-13 NIV)

Thursday 8 May: Pray for FEBA’s ministry in Mali and Niger. Islam is interwoven with the culture in both countries and believers are often abused or rejected as unnatural. Many have no church or pastors to support them. Pray that FEBA Mali and FEBA Niger’s broadcasts will comfort believers and inspire others to seek the true God.

Friday 9 May: Praise God for FEBA’s growing ministry in Malawi! FEBA Malawi’s broadcasts reach the whole of central and southern Malawi, with Yao listeners in Tanzania tuning into its shortwave broadcasts. Pray that FEBA Malawi’s team will remain strong in their faith and that listeners will be open to receive the Good News through FEBA’s programs.

Saturday & Sunday 10-11 May: Pray for the people of Myanmar and Thailand who were impacted by the devastating earthquake at the end of March. Thousands lost their lives, and many more, including some of FEBA's staff, had to flee their homes. Pray that those who have lost loved ones and their homes will feel God's comfort and look to Him for hope and salvation. Ask that He would use FEBA Myanmar and FEBA Thailand to spread His love and bring hope to those rebuilding their lives.

Monday 12 May: Jesus had immense compassion with the marginalised. FEBA Philippines is walking in His footsteps with its Blessing Rahab program, which shares God's love with survivors of sex trafficking through practical help. Pray that God will free victims of trafficking and that FEBA Philippines' programs will help survivors to find shelter in Him.

Tuesday 13 May: "When I first believed in Jesus, my whole family was against me ... However, in the past 30 years, [they] have come to believe in the Lord one after another. No one is opposed to me, and the rest is being led to faith now. Every morning, I listen to FEBA's monthly broadcast MP3 disc and receive encouragement." (FEBA listener in Japan)

Wednesday 14 May: "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." (Ephesians 2:8-10 NIV)

Thursday 15 May: Today is International Day of Families. Family can be one's greatest blessing, but for many, sin has turned it into a curse. FEBA shares God's Word with families all over the world through radio and online broadcasts, as well as family seminars. Pray that families will find healing and encouragement through FEBA's ministry.

Friday 16 May: Many people in rural Cambodia have unreliable electricity in their homes. When FEBA Cambodia's follow-up workers visit these places, they distribute solar lights along with radios, transforming people's evenings at home. Praise God for the opportunity to share His light with listeners and pray that FEBA Cambodia's programs will draw listeners to Christ.

Saturday & Sunday 17-18 May: Although less than 1% of Japan's population is Christian, the church is carrying on the work of sharing God's love with a country that desperately needs it. FEBA Japan is actively exploring different avenues to expand its reach, especially among young people, so that it can shine the light of the gospel amid the darkness of declining mental health and rising despair. Pray that God will open doors for FEBA Japan, so that they can proclaim His Word until all in Japan have heard it.

Monday 19 May: In Taiwan, people participate in many rituals to earn salvation from their gods. Many struggle with the concept of grace that is freely given. FEBA Taiwan broadcasts in three local languages, and its programs are produced by people who understand the culture. Pray that each broadcast will help listeners to understand and accept God's grace.

Tuesday 20 May: "[Book Corner] has become a must-listen program for me. One of the books ... helped me to give thanks to God for my bodily pain! Through gratitude, I experienced God's miraculous healing - I went from struggling to walk, to being able to take care of myself, and now I can even do work within my ability." (FEBA listener in Taiwan)

Wednesday 21 May: "Sing the praises of the Lord, you his faithful people; praise his holy name. For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favour lasts a lifetime; weeping may stay for the night, but rejoicing comes in the morning." (Psalm 30:4-5 NIV)

Thursday 22 May: Pray for FEBA Hong Kong's radio station, Sooradio, which faithfully broadcasts the Good News in Cantonese. Mental health issues, drug use, and suicide are growing problems in Hong Kong, especially among the youth. Pray that FEBA Hong Kong's content will inspire listeners to look to God for hope and strength.

Friday 23 May: FEBA China's theological seminary equips church leaders to share the Good News and pastor their congregations in difficult conditions. The course is done online and through correspondence, to make it more accessible and avoid unwanted attention. Pray that FEBA China's theological seminary will train strong workers to bring in the harvest in China.

Saturday & Sunday 24-25 May: Differently abled believers often struggle to enjoy fellowship with other believers, because it is physically too difficult to attend church. The challenges of daily life can also be exhausting to them and their families. That is why FEBA Philippines partners with the God is Able Foundation to broadcast programs for people affected by disabilities, bringing them fellowship and an understanding community. Pray that FEBA Philippines' programs will allow differently abled listeners and their families to find strength and companionship in Christ.

Monday 26 May: FEBA Indonesia is receiving increased resistance from authorities, especially when they share the gospel with Muslims. The team recently started broadcasting a new radio program for believers who live in areas governed by Sharia law. Pray that God will use FEBA Indonesia's programs to renew the authorities' minds and bring revival in Indonesia.

Tuesday 27 May: "After listening to FEBA, I found forgiveness while grieving, crying before God and realising that He is good. Now I live in peace, relying on God and believing He will never abandon me." (FEBA listener in Indonesia)

Wednesday 28 May: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (John 14:27 NIV)

Thursday 29 May: On Ascension Day, we are reminded of the Great Commission: to go and make disciples of all nations. Praise the Lord of the harvest and pray that listeners will respond to FEBA's programs with open hearts. Ask also that the global Church will continue - through media and personal witness - the work Jesus gave us to do.

Friday 30 May: FEBA Ukraine's program, Embrace, is creating a community for women who are feeling worn down by the war. Through radio broadcasts, digital media, and in-person gatherings, FEBA Ukraine shares the gospel and provides a space for them to share their struggles. Ask that God will walk with each woman who participates in FEBA Ukraine's Embrace program.

Saturday & Sunday 31 May-1 June: FEBA ELSEA (Ethnic Languages of Southeast Asia) is a living example of the Book of Acts. Staff from more than 20 language teams travel to remote areas to visit and encourage listeners, pray for the sick, and teach people about God's Word. They often travel in secret, because some of them have been arrested for spreading the gospel. Pray that God will strengthen their faith to overcome every obstacle and ask Him to make the seeds grow where the ministry has planted them.
