

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



JUNE 2025

Monday 2 June: FEBA ELSEA regularly hosts camps for young people from ethnic minorities, where they share the gospel and give Bible teaching. Poverty is rife in the mountains of Southeast Asia and many young people live without hope for the future. Pray that FEBA ELSEA's camps and broadcasts will inspire the youth to find their hope in Christ.

Tuesday 3 June: "Though we have never met, are not related, and live in different countries, we feel connected through God's love. I just want to say – we love this radio program." (FEBA listener from the Mien people group)

Wednesday 4 June: "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labour in the Lord is not in vain." (1 Corinthians 15:58 NIV)

Thursday 5 June: Pray for the leaders of FEBA ELSEA, who must lead more than 20 language teams in sharing the gospel throughout the mountains of Southeast Asia. The teams encounter all kinds of danger and opposition. Pray that FEBA ELSEA's leaders will guide their teams with God's wisdom and protection.

Friday 6 June: Did you know? Russian is the world's 8th most spoken language, with around 260 million speakers. Since the late 1940s, FEBA has shared the Good News with Russian speakers, and continues, despite opposition. Pray for strength and boldness for the FEBA Russia team, and that their faithful service bears fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 7-8 June: The Buryat are a Mongolian ethnic group with a population of around 500,000 who mostly live in Siberia. They are unreached – less than 1% of Buryat are Christian, while the majority practise a blend of Buddhism and shamanism. Moreover, they have no access to an up-to-date Bible in their language. FEBA broadcasts the Good News to the Buryat people in their own language. Pray that Buryat listeners will open their hearts and come to know Christ through FEBA's broadcasts.

Monday 9 June: Today, let us lift up the people of Ukraine and Russia in prayer. Both countries have already paid a high price in this war. Pray for the FEBA teams who broadcast every day, despite risk and personal pain, and pray that the listeners who turn to FEBA's programs will find the truth and hope they seek.

Tuesday 10 June: "I learned so much from your programs – all the different ways we can help the children. My husband and I are not able to adopt, but now I am volunteering with these kids. It is amazing to see them open up to the world, to begin to change. And they are so open to learning more about Jesus." (FEBA listener in Russia)

Wednesday 11 June: "And we boast in the hope of the glory of God ... we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us." (Romans 5:2-5 NIV)

Thursday 12 June: Pray for the leaders of FEBA Russia and FEBA Ukraine. In Russia, the team must contend with fines and scrutiny from authorities, while the team in Ukraine must contend with the daily realities of war. Pray that God will grant FEBA leaders the wisdom and strength to lead their teams safely through challenging times.

Friday 13 June: FEBA Kazakhstan is conducting seminars to discuss the questions they receive during broadcasts. Many of those who attend are Muslim and discussions can be challenging. Pray for FEBA Kazakhstan's team to be full of the Spirit when they engage with listeners, so that each word guides people closer to Christ.

Saturday & Sunday 14-15 June: Alcohol abuse is a major problem in Moldova and children often bear the brunt of their parents' addiction. This is why FEBA Moldova focuses a lot of energy on its youth programs. From a program for small children to teach them about the love of Jesus, to Bible studies and gatherings for teenagers, FEBA uses every possible means to connect the youth of Moldova with Christ. Pray that FEBA's programs will introduce the youth of Moldova to God and help them to walk in His ways.

Monday 16 June: Anxiety and despair are unfortunately widespread among today's youth. Many feel lost in challenging circumstances. FEBA broadcasts youth programs in more than 150 languages, encouraging them to cast their burdens on the Lord and experience His peace. Pray that these programs will bring comfort and hope to each listener.

Tuesday 17 June: "I really believe in what you are doing. Thank you for helping me with advice and equipment. I really want to learn from you!" (Christian, a teenager from Moldova who is partnering with FEBA to reach his peers with the gospel. Please pray that his ministry will bear fruit.)

Wednesday 18 June: "That is why we labour and strive, because we have put our hope in the living God, who is the Saviour of all people, and especially of those who believe ... Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity." (1 Timothy 4:10-12 NIV)

Thursday 19 June: Pray for the hosts of FEBA Kyrgyzstan's Bible program. They host a live program where they teach the Muslim community about Jesus and the Bible. Kyrgyzstan recently passed a law that makes it more challenging to share the gospel. Pray for God's guidance and wisdom as the team carries out FEBA's mission.

Friday 20 June: A wave of jihadist attacks recently occurred in Niassa Province, Mozambique. People were brutally attacked and killed. FEBA has three radio stations in Niassa – Fountain of Truth, Radio Chiuanjota, and Victory FM. Pray for the staff and listeners, and pray that FEBA Mozambique's broadcasts will reach the jihadists' hearts, for nothing is impossible with God.

Saturday & Sunday 21-22 June: The construction of FEBA Sudan's radio station in the Nuba Mountains is well underway, but there is still a lot of work ahead! The area has very little infrastructure, poor roads, no electricity or water infrastructure, and poor cell reception. However, the surrounding community is very positive about the new station. Pray for the safe construction of the building, for the right staff, for strong relationships and open hearts. Ask also for God's wisdom as the team seeks solutions to every obstacle.

Monday 23 June: A new shipment of FEBA's radios has been sent to Malawi and Mozambique, where they will be distributed to listener clubs in remote areas. Pray for God's blessing on each radio and ask that every broadcast will speak to listeners' hearts and provide the encouragement they need.

Tuesday 24 June: "Having listened to KanuYah FM for several months, I have finally learned the most efficient problem-solving technique – prayer. As a result, I have been led to Christ, in whose name I always pray. I have no words to describe the positive change in my life as God has taken control of everything." (FEBA listener in Mali)

Wednesday 25 June: "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him." (James 1:12 NIV)

Thursday 26 June: In addition to its broadcasts in French and Arabic, FEBA Chad aims to start broadcasting in two more languages, including Ngambay, which has about one million native speakers. Pray for God's wisdom as FEBA Chad creates content in these languages and ask Him to prepare people's hearts to receive His Word.

Friday 27 June: FEBA is part of the Yemen Project, a network of organisations working together to share the gospel with the Yemeni people. The project broadcasts evangelical programs, including FEBA's Reality Church, via shortwave radio and supports the church within Yemen. Pray for God's blessing and protection on the Yemen Project, and for the programs to yield abundant fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 28-29 June: FEBA's partner in Iraq recently started broadcasting a new program, featuring believers' testimonies. Many listeners have contacted the station to find out more about Jesus. The team is also expanding its ministry to another city, which has a population of 1.3 million. God is already preparing people's hearts there – they have already contacted the radio station, asking for Bibles! Praise God for His provision and pray for the protection of FEBA's partners, as well as their listeners, in a country where believers are persecuted.

Monday 30 June: About 98% of Pakistan's population remains unreached. Islam permeates the country and the culture, leaving little opportunity to hear the gospel. FEBA Pakistan broadcasts on FM radio, medium- and shortwave radio, and on social media. Pray that every broadcast will draw new listeners and plant the seed of the gospel in their hearts.
