

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



JULY 2025

Tuesday 1 July: "I was struggling to hear God's voice during a difficult time. Through your program, Eternal Life, I found clarity, peace, and a renewed relationship with my God. Thank you for guiding me toward the right path." Praise God for His grace and pray for His continued blessing on this listener and FEBA Pakistan's Eternal Life program.

Wednesday 2 July: "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust'" (Psalm 91:1-2 NIV). Praise God for His promise to be a refuge to His children in times of trouble.

Thursday 3 July: Pray for FEBA Pakistan Director Shahzad, who must lead his team in challenging circumstances. The team prays Psalm 91 together before leaving the office, knowing that their physical safety is never guaranteed. Pray that Director Shahzad will remain anchored in God's love and strength, and that FEBA Pakistan will bear great fruit under his leadership.

Friday 4 July: Pray for FEBA's team and listeners in India. Anti-Christian sentiment is growing in certain parts of the country, with malicious videos on social media trying to instigate violence. Pray for God's protection over His children and for His peace in people's hearts, so that FEBA can keep broadcasting His Word, until all in India have heard.

Saturday & Sunday 5-6 July: Praise God for the successful completion of FEBA Sudan's facilities! By His grace, the radio station, staff accommodation, and a 90-metre tower were completed in just three months. FEBA Sudan has a potential audience of nearly 4 million, due to the high number of refugees in the region, but the team still needs dedicated and knowledgeable staff to produce broadcasts. Pray for the right people to join FEBA Sudan's team and ask for God's guidance as they start creating content to bring Christ to their listeners.

Monday 7 July: Did you know that today is World Kiswahili Day? Swahili is spoken by approximately 50 million people in sub-Saharan Africa. It is also one of the eight languages in which Victory FM, FEBA Mozambique's new station in Cuamba, broadcasts. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts will reach many unreached Swahili-speakers with God's Word.

Tuesday 8 July: "When we heard the gospel [through Litala FM], our lives changed for the better. The Lord told us that we should start telling others about Jesus, so we created 45 listener clubs." Praise God for working through FEBA Malawi's programs and pray for His blessing on these listener clubs.

Wednesday 9 July: “So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness” (Colossians 2:6-7 NIV). Pray that every FEBA listener who comes to Christ will grow in faith and thankfulness.

Thursday 10 July: Pray for FEBA Chad’s director, Ayata, and his team. They are working hard to proclaim the Good News in the N’Djamena area, where Islam is the dominant religion. Pray for God’s protection over the radio station and staff, and pray that FEBA Chad’s programs will draw every listener to Him.

Friday 11 July: KanuYah FM, FEBA’s station in Mali, has earned such a reputation for its prayer programs that even Muslims are sending in requests! The sick are being healed and Muslims are discovering Christ as Saviour. Pray that God will continue to use M’Bimba, FEBA Mali’s director, and his team as powerful vessels of the Good News.

Saturday & Sunday 12-13 July: The Mien are an ethnic minority group spread throughout the mountains of Southeast Asia. They practise shamanism and each village has a shaman who serves as a bridge between the human and spirit worlds. When these shamans accept Christ, they and their families are ostracised by their villages. FEBA ELSEA (Ethnic Languages of Southeast Asia) frequently travel to visit these listeners and offer prayer and encouragement. Pray that every Mien shaman will hear the Good News through FEBA ELSEA’s broadcasts and share it with their community.

Monday 14 July: Sharing the gospel with ethnic minorities in the mountains of Southeast Asia carries great risk, and many villages are resistant to God’s Word. Pray for the safety of FEBA ELSEA’s director, Nopp, and his team as they travel to isolated areas. Ask also that people’s hearts will be prepared to receive the Good News.

Tuesday 15 July: “I am a student, and it is far more enjoyable when I can also engage in evangelism. [Through this training] I have come to understand that I am capable and equipped to proclaim the Good News through my social media account.” Praise God for using FEBA Indonesia’s training to raise up a new generation of evangelists.

Wednesday 16 July: “Do not say, “I am too young.” You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you ...” (Jeremiah 1:7-8 NIV). Pray that FEBA’s youth programs will inspire listeners to share the gospel with their peers.

Thursday 17 July: FEBA Thailand is participating in “Love Thailand 1-1-1”, which aims to see 1 million Thai believers, 10 000 churches, and 10 000 pastors in Thailand by 2028. This requires earnest prayer. Pray for God’s blessing on the “Love Thailand 1-1-1” project. Also take one minute to pray for one Thai person to accept Christ as Saviour.

Friday 18 July: On Mandela Day, people give back to the community. Charity is integral to the gospel and forms a central part of FEBA’s ministry, be it through free trauma counselling or sharing food and clothing with the poor. Praise God for His provision and pray that every act of kindness in His name will draw people to Him.

Saturday & Sunday 19-20 July: The people of Russia and Ukraine are physically and mentally exhausted by the war. However, it is also prompting them to seek Christ. FEBA’s teams are always ready to share Him with listeners, because they know only He can bring everlasting peace in the midst of war. Pray for God’s strength for FEBA’s teams in Russia and Ukraine as they keep stepping out in faith to combat fear, and pray for God’s healing and comfort for the staff members who are ill or grieving.

Monday 21 July: Pray for FEBA Ukraine’s director, Eduard Kurylenko. FEBA Ukraine shows up every day to proclaim God’s Word, despite their own illness and loss, despite fear for their children and other loved ones – and Eduard leads by example. Pray that his faith, strength and courage will be renewed every day.

Tuesday 22 July: “Your prayers are helping me to go on living and taking care of my daughter. It’s been 40 days since my wife died,” Dmitry recently told FEBA Russia’s prayer evangelists. “I feel like I’m going through that valley [of the shadow of death] myself right now.” Pray for Dmitry and for others who feel lost in grief.

Wednesday 23 July: "Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me ..." (Psalm 23:4 NKJV). Praise the God of all comfort, who promises to take us by the hand and help us in all circumstances.

Thursday 24 July: Every day, FEBA Russia's prayer evangelists deal with traumatised, disillusioned, and grieving people who contact FEBA for help that they cannot find anywhere else. The work can be rewarding but also draining. Pray for FEBA Russia's prayer evangelists to be filled with God's strength and Spirit, so that they never grow weary of doing good.

Friday 25 July: Kyrgyzstan is a largely Muslim country, but people want to learn more about Jesus. Now, local churches and Christian organisations are hosting summer programs and using FEBA Kyrgyzstan's resources to share the Good News with participants. Pray that these programs will bear abundant fruit and encourage people to turn to Christ.

Saturday & Sunday 26-27 July: Courageous leadership is essential to effective evangelism. FEBA invests in its future leaders through the Leadership Academy, which equips them to lead teams that broadcast the Good News in a variety of contexts, each with its unique challenges and opportunities. This week, FEBA directors and up-and-coming leaders will travel to Cambodia for a week of training. Pray that all the attendees will arrive safely and that this year's Leadership Academy will yield courageous leaders to carry FEBA's mission into the future.

Monday 28 July: Pray for FEBA Radio SA's national director, Dr Jurie Vermeulen, who is travelling to the annual Leadership Academy in Cambodia this week. He will give training on the apostle Paul's leadership model. Pray for God's protection on Dr Jurie as he travels, and for His blessing on the Leadership Academy.

Tuesday 29 July: "I'm so thankful to God for FEBA Philippines on my radio ... I've learned so much, and it feels like I'm with you, especially when you're having a good laugh. Sometimes, when I have a question, God uses your programs to answer it." Praise God for the opportunity to bring Christ to the world through media.

Wednesday 30 July: "He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners ..." (Isaiah 61:1 NIV). Pray that God will use FEBA to bring freedom to those in spiritual and physical captivity.

Thursday 31 July: Pray for FEBA's leaders who are attending the Leadership Academy in Cambodia this week. Whether it is war in Ukraine or poverty in Mozambique, each leader must guide their team through challenging circumstances. Pray for God's wisdom as they train their successors to take up the baton and bring Christ to the world through media.
