

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



AUGUST 2025

Friday 1 August: Please pray for Ed Cannon, chairman of FEBA International, and the Executive Committee. Alongside leading their own regions, they also guide FEBA's global strategy across diverse cultures and equip teams to carry out the Great Commission. Ask for God's protection in their travels and His wisdom as they lead FEBA's mission to share Christ through media.

Saturday & Sunday 2-3 August: It is estimated that conflict levels around the world have doubled in the past five years. The number of armed conflicts is the highest it has been since World War II. For many people in these regions FEBA's broadcasts serve as a voice of hope and comfort in the chaos. Pray that FEBA's staff and listeners who live in conflict zones will grow strong in their faith and experience the riches of God's grace.

Monday 4 August: Pray for an end to the war between Russia and Ukraine. People are exhausted by fear and grief, and FEBA's teams contend with many troubles even as they proclaim God's Word. Pray that FEBA's staff will receive sufficient strength for every day, and that listeners will find peace in Christ.

Tuesday 5 August: Please pray for believers in Myanmar. One minister shares, "We are now scattered [due to the war], yet we thank God for His presence with us wherever we go ... In places where we can still find signal, we listen to God's Word through [FEBA] radio. This brings us comfort and strength in these uncertain times."

Wednesday 6 August: "The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit" (Psalm 34:17-18 NIV). Pray that every FEBA listener in difficult circumstances will experience God's closeness.

Thursday 7 August: War has left the people of Yemen with limited access to food, water, and basic healthcare. FEBA is part of the Yemen Project, which broadcasts the gospel into Yemen from outside its borders. Pray for God to provide Yemeni believers with their daily needs and make the Yemen Project fruitful.

Friday 8 August: According to the UN, the civil war in Sudan has created "the world's worst humanitarian crisis". Millions of people have been displaced, with many fleeing to the area where FEBA Sudan's Living Hope Radio is now broadcasting. Pray that FEBA Sudan's programs will plant the seed of living hope in listeners' hearts.

Saturday & Sunday 9-10 August: At FEBA, there are hundreds of mothers, daughters, sisters, aunts, and friends serving behind the microphone or behind the scenes, and they reach millions of female listeners in 50 countries. Wives suffering domestic violence in Kyrgyzstan, widows who farm in Mozambique, prostitutes in the Philippines, women caught in Ukraine's war – FEBA hears from all of these and more. Pray that every woman in FEBA's ministry will grow in her faith and walk with God, so that she may serve as a blessing to others.

Monday 11 August: FEBA Ukraine's Embrace program reaches out to army widows, partners, and daughters through radio programs, social media, and in-person gatherings. The program not only introduces women to the gospel but also creates a space to share their burdens. Pray that the Embrace program will bring healing to the women of Ukraine.

Tuesday 12 August: "Comfort at Night has changed my life. As a wife and mother, I often carried silent burdens, but this program reminded me that I'm not alone. Each message gave me strength to stand firm in faith and love my family with greater purpose." Praise God for empowering women and making them feel loved through FEBA Radio.

Wednesday 13 August: "For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well" (Psalm 139:13-14 NIV). Pray that every FEBA listener will come to know God's wonderful works and everlasting love.

Thursday 14 August: Poverty has driven many women in Davao City, Philippines, into prostitution. FEBA Philippines shares the gospel with these women through the Blessing Rahab program, which also equips them to find alternative income streams. Pray that every woman in the Blessing Rahab program will put her faith in Christ and leave her old life behind.

Friday 15 August: Some of FEBA Mozambique's female listeners, including widows and former Muslims, have begun training others to dramatise Bible stories for radio. FEBA Mozambique broadcasts these radio dramas to reach women, as well as the youth. Praise God for this initiative and pray that FEBA Mozambique's radio dramas will have a lasting impact on listeners.

Saturday & Sunday 16-17 August: The Lausanne Movement estimates that there is only one Christian missionary for every 400,000 unreached Muslims in the world. Many unreached Muslims live in countries where access to the gospel is restricted, but radio and digital media can still reach them. FEBA's broadcasts and ministry in Muslim majority countries like Pakistan and Niger, and to large Muslim populations in countries like Russia and the Philippines, are bearing fruit. Pray that FEBA will be allowed to continue broadcasting to Muslims and bring in a great harvest for the Lord.

Monday 18 August: Please pray for FEBA's new ministry in Uzbekistan, a secular state with a Muslim-majority population. FEBA Uzbekistan shares the gospel through videos on social media and while some people respond with insults and threats, many show genuine interest. The team is seeing amazing results. Pray that FEBA Uzbekistan's faithfulness and perseverance will bear lasting fruit.

Tuesday 19 August: "I see the truths from the Bible that you share, but when I read the Quran, it is so different ... I can feel the truth in what you say about God, but everyone around me is against Christianity. I don't know what to do." Pray that this listener from Uzbekistan will put her faith in Christ.

Wednesday 20 August: "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me" (Rev. 3:20 NIV). For many Muslim listeners, FEBA's broadcasts serve as that knock on the door. Pray that they will open their hearts to Christ.

Thursday 21 August: FEBA reaches out to Muslim immigrant communities throughout Russia. Through FEBA's talk shows, videos, and follow-up work, those who feel marginalised learn that they are valued by God, and many respond to His call. Pray for God's wisdom as FEBA Russia guides Muslims to Christ and connects them with local churches.

Friday 22 August: Some FEBA listeners are too afraid to meet with other believers, because they live in communities that are hostile to Christianity. Today, as the world commemorates victims who have suffered violence because of their religion, please lift up in prayer the FEBA staff and listeners who suffer physical, verbal, and psychological violence for their faith.

Saturday & Sunday 23-24 August: In February, one of FEBA's presenters in a hostile region of Southeast Asia was killed for his faith. All over the world, persecuted believers experience not only physical danger but also isolation and loneliness. Many cannot meet with fellow Christians or share their faith in public. To them, a voice on the radio can become a companion and FEBA's social media channels offer a chance to engage with fellow believers in safety. Pray that God will strengthen FEBA's persecuted staff and listeners in their faith and give them hope.

Monday 25 August: Please pray for believers in India and Pakistan, where they suffer increasing discrimination and oppression. FEBA broadcasts on radio and digital platforms in both countries, and both teams do follow-up work with listeners, at great personal risk. Pray that God will fill FEBA India, FEBA Pakistan, and their listeners with hope, joy and peace.

Tuesday 26 August: "These lessons have greatly increased my knowledge and understanding, which have been very helpful in my ministry. They have also inspired me to love evangelism even more and to boldly and powerfully share the story of Jesus." Pray for God's blessing on this listener in Laos, where there is much resistance to the gospel.

Wednesday 27 August: "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you" (Matthew 5:11-12 NIV). Pray that persecuted believers everywhere will draw strength from God's promises.

Thursday 28 August: Pray for believers in Southeast Asian ethnic minorities. Most of them are shunned by their communities when they turn to Christ, yet millions have responded to FEBA ELSEA's broadcasts on shortwave and social media. Pray that FEBA ELSEA and its listeners will grow in their knowledge of God's Word and find solace in His presence.

Friday 29 August: Authorities in China continue to restrict religious activity and children younger than 18 are not allowed to participate. Despite the challenges, however, FEBA China continues to share the gospel and equip church leaders, and its efforts are bearing fruit. Pray that FEBA China and its listeners will persevere and that the church in China will keep growing.

Saturday & Sunday 30-31 August: FEBA broadcasts in Mozambique, Malawi, Chad, Mali, Niger, and Sudan, where violent conflict and desperate poverty are commonplace. The teams in these countries share the Good News through radio broadcasts and practical means, travelling to remote villages to distribute radios and audio Bibles, baptise new believers, and encourage listeners. Pray that FEBA Africa's teams will never grow weary of doing good. Pray also that the listeners will put their faith in God and share that faith with others.
