

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



OCTOBER 2025

Wednesday 1 October: “We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life” (Romans 6:4 ESV). Praise God for the gift of new beginnings and pray that listeners will discover it through FEBA.

Thursday 2 October: Please pray for Nopp and his FEBA ELSEA team as they minister to ethnic minority groups in remote parts of Southeast Asia. In addition to translating and producing content, they travel difficult routes to share the gospel and support believers in hostile communities. Pray for God’s protection, wisdom, and strength in their ministry.

Friday 3 October: Pray for FEBA ELSEA’s Hmong listeners in Laos and Vietnam, where they follow Christ at great personal risk. Hundreds of believers attend Bible study on Zoom with FEBA’s Hmong broadcaster, Phairot, and they are hungry for the gospel. Pray that FEBA ELSEA’s listeners will draw strength from God’s Word and lead others to Him.

Saturday & Sunday 4-5 October: In the Philippines, some people lack access to education, either because they have no school within travelling distance or because circumstances force them to start working at a young age. FEBA Philippines collaborates with its government to broadcast programs that give people the opportunity to complete their basic education, which opens doors to new possibilities for the future. Praise God for using FEBA Philippines to bring hope through education and pray that its broadcasts will inspire listeners to put their faith in Christ.

Monday 6 October: Pray for FEBA’s follow-up workers in Eurasia. They build relationships with listeners over the phone, travel to meet them, put them in contact with local churches, and arrange for them to receive Bibles – even in places where the gospel is unwelcome. Pray that they will receive sufficient strength and courage for each day.

Tuesday 7 October: Please pray for FEBA Ukraine’s listeners. Dmitry, who lives in Pokrovsk, recently shared, “We have to be very careful when we walk outside. We run from tree to tree so that drone operators don’t see us and kill us. I just became a father, and I need to stay alive for my son. Your programs give us hope.”

Wednesday 8 October: “O my Strength, I will sing praises to you, for you, O God, are my fortress, the God who shows me steadfast love” (Psalm 59:17 ESV). Pray that FEBA Ukraine’s staff and listeners will endure in faith and take shelter in God’s steadfast love.

Thursday 9 October: Please pray for FEBA Eurasia's leaders – Ulanbek, Alexey, Oleg, Eduard, Igor, Ruslan, Umida, Ilia, Victor, and Rudi. Their teams work in difficult and dangerous environments where the gospel is desperately needed. Pray that God will equip them to lead with wisdom, courage, and faithfulness to His Word.

Friday 10 October: Today is World Mental Health Day. Listeners of all ages contact FEBA Ukraine and FEBA Russia in search of help for their fear, anxiety, and depression, and FEBA shares with them the greatest source of hope and healing: the gospel. Pray that these listeners will put their faith in Christ and find their hope and strength in Him.

Saturday & Sunday 11-12 October: Tajikistan is the smallest state in Central Asia and more than 90% of its population practise Islam. Religion is heavily regulated, and Christians are not allowed to share their faith in person or in print. FEBA's presenters use voice changers to hide their identities as they share God's Word through short Bible programs, and they recently launched a program for teenagers on social media. Pray for God's protection and courage as FEBA Tajikistan proclaim the gospel, and ask Him to bring revival in their country.

Monday 13 October: Pray for FEBA Kazakhstan's youth meetings, where non-Christian and Christian young people gather to play games and get to know each other. This creates an environment where FEBA can share the gospel in a spontaneous way. Pray that many young Kazakh non-Christians will attend the meetings and open their hearts to Christ.

Tuesday 14 October: Pray for listeners in Uzbekistan, like Yulia, who is discovering joy in Christ amid great personal challenges. Yulia, who suffers from cancer and diabetes, says, "I have hope. I can speak with my Father in heaven now. I am reading my Bible every day!"

Wednesday 15 October: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! Let your gentle spirit be known to all people. The Lord is near" (Philippians 4:4-5 NASB). Praise God for the millions of people who are able to hear the Good News through FEBA, and ask that they would be filled with joy in Christ.

Thursday 16 October: A 12-year-old boy in Moldova recently told FEBA, "The first time I heard that someone loves me was in your program." FEBA Moldova's programs introduce children and young adults to the gospel through videos, podcasts, and gatherings. Pray that FEBA Moldova will help many more young people to know God's love in Christ.

Friday 17 October: Please pray for FEBA Kyrgyzstan. In addition to health problems and technical difficulties, the team must contend with hostility and restricted freedom. Their Bible program draws a lot of negative feedback, yet some of these responses turn into sincere conversations. Pray for strength and healing and ask that FEBA Kyrgyzstan's efforts will bear lasting fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 18-19 October: The FEBA team in India is working in an increasingly difficult environment. In parts of the country, extremists are targeting Christians through threats, raids, and physical violence, while anti-conversion laws are becoming stricter. The team continues to broadcast God's Word faithfully and also creates programs to educate listeners on topics like mental health, human trafficking, and problems in the workplace. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts in India will encourage persecuted believers to persevere in faith and also draw non-believers to Christ.

Monday 20 October: Pray for FEBA's ministry in Pakistan, where the team shares the gospel through multiple radio and online channels, despite opposition. Praise God for His faithful protection of the staff and pray for wisdom and creativity as they develop new content. Ask also for more opportunities to reach remote communities across Pakistan.

Tuesday 21 October: Praise God for blessing FEBA Pakistan's Eternal Life program with 30 years on air. One listener shares, "The Eternal Life program is like a church for me and my family. The way the reverend explains God's Word has touched my soul and led me to follow Jesus Christ. Today, my whole family – five of us – believe in Him."

Wednesday 22 October: "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life" (John 5:24 ESV). Pray that FEBA's programs will help listeners to attain eternal life through faith in Christ.

Thursday 23 October: Pray for FEBA's follow-up workers in India and Pakistan. Due to security concerns, they mainly engage with listeners online and must always be ready for difficult conversations. Pray for more volunteers to do follow-up work in these countries and that they will be prepared to give a reason for the hope they have.

Friday 24 October: Pray for FEBA's ministry to Muslims in South Asia, Eurasia, Southeast Asia, and Africa. Every culture presents its own challenges, but people's hearts are hungry for the gospel. Pray that teams will remain sensitive to God's guidance when they create new content and when they engage with listeners to share the gospel.

Saturday & Sunday 25-26 October: FEBA Chad is faithfully proclaiming the Good News in the N'Djamena area and listeners are keen to engage with the prayer program. Most of the requests involve praying for employment. While Chad has one of the lowest unemployment rates in Africa, it is one of the least developed countries in the world, and the average income is very low. Pray that FEBA Chad will help listeners to seek the kingdom of God and put their faith in Him to provide for all their needs.

Monday 27 October: Pray for FEBA Malawi's ministry among the Yao people. Pray for sufficient resources and open hearts to receive them, for safe travels and wisdom, and for God's provision for those who receive Christ at the cost of everything else. Praise Him for the churches being planted by FEBA listeners in Malawi, Mozambique, and Tanzania!

Tuesday 28 October: A listener in Chad recently requested prayer for his mother, who was ill. A week later, he said, "I give thanks to God for all these wonders in my mother's life; thanks to your prayers, her health is already improving well. I ask you to pray again for her to regain perfect health completely." Praise God!

Wednesday 29 October: "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him'" (John 14:6-7 ESV). Pray that FEBA's listeners will come to know the Father through Christ.

Thursday 30 October: Pray for FEBA's stations in Mali, Niger, and Sudan. All three countries have suffered terrible conflict for years, leaving millions displaced and impoverished. Pray for relief from violence and food shortages. Ask also that listeners will find peace in God's Word through FEBA's broadcasts and put their faith in Christ as their Saviour.

Friday 31 October: All over the world, FEBA relies on partnership with local churches. When a listener is ready to commit to the Lord, FEBA teams put them in contact with local communities of believers, who can help them mature in the faith. Pray for strong partnerships between FEBA and the local churches in every community they serve.
