

MONTHLY E-PRAYER FOCUS



DECEMBER 2025

Monday 1 December: In Cuamba, Mozambique, women living with HIV are being trained to produce a radio program in which HIV patients share how their communities and families responded to their diagnosis, and how FEBA Mozambique's discipleship program helped them overcome their situation. Pray that this radio program will comfort those with HIV and AIDS and draw them to Christ.

Tuesday 2 December: "Thanks to KanuYah FM (FEBA Mali), I am learning the Bible secretly and praying the Christian prayer many times a day. I practise Christianity the best I can but have to do everything in hiding. Please pray for me so that I can freely and openly practise Christianity, the only Way to heaven."

Wednesday 3 December: "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone" (Isaiah 9:2 ESV). This month, we celebrate God's greatest gift – Christ, the Light that cannot be overcome by darkness. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts will open people's eyes to the Light this Christmas season.

Thursday 4 December: Pray for FEBA Niger. The team faithfully proclaims the gospel despite resistance, and positive responses are scarce. Listeners who put their faith in Christ risk their lives and livelihoods to follow Him. Pray that FEBA Niger and its listeners will persevere in faith and ask that God will provide growth.

Friday 5 December: Pray for FEBA's directors in Africa – Dr Jurie Vermeulen, Bright, Amos, Ayata, M'Bimba, and Godi. Each one leads a team in difficult circumstances and with limited resources. Pray that they will grow in their knowledge of God and follow His guidance. Ask also for wisdom as FEBA Sudan builds its ministry.

Saturday & Sunday 6-7 December: In most East Asian countries, Christmas is celebrated as a couples' holiday and carries no spiritual significance. FEBA's teams faithfully broadcast the gospel in Japan, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and the Koreas – even where it seems as if the seed is falling on hard ground. But the harvest is ripe, and Christmas offers new opportunities to share God's Word. Pray for FEBA's directors in East Asia – respectively Seiji, Luke, Aaron, Daniel, and Ki-Boong – as they lead their teams in carrying out the Great Commission this Christmas.

Monday 8 December: Pray for FEBA Korea's director, Han Ki-Boong, and his team. In addition to 13 FM stations nationwide, they also broadcast to North Korea. Many responses come from listeners who are rediscovering God after drifting away from Him. Pray that the FEBA Korea team and their listeners will experience the fullness of God's grace.

Tuesday 9 December: Praise God for this testimony from South Korea: "I used to live like the prodigal son, but after listening to FEBA, my life changed. I started going to church and praying, and by God's grace, I quit drinking and smoking overnight. It was not by my own strength, but only through God's help."

Wednesday 10 December: "He will not cry aloud or lift up his voice, or make it heard in the street; a bruised reed he will not break, and a faintly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice" (Isaiah 42:2-3 ESV). Praise God for saving us through His boundless strength and compassion.

Thursday 11 December: Pray for FEBA Hong Kong director, Daniel Chow, and his team. They broadcast to Mainland China through Liangyou Radio, and to their Cantonese audience through Soooradio. The team frequently faces efforts to block their content. Pray for God's protection over FEBA Hong Kong's channels, so that His Word can broadcast without interruption this festive season.

Friday 12 December: The gospel reached Japan 476 years ago, yet less than 1% of the population are evangelical Christians today. Japanese culture is deeply rooted in Shintoism and Buddhism, and governed by strict social rules. Pray that God will guide FEBA Japan's efforts to share the gospel with its listeners, and ask that every broadcast will bear fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 13-14 December: In Pakistan, 25 December commemorates the country's founder. Most people know Christmas only if they have access to media from other countries, yet curiosity opens many hearts at this time of year. FEBA Pakistan's special Christmas programs, in which they share the true meaning of Christmas and the gospel, have received positive responses from non-believers in previous years. Pray for Director Shahzad and the FEBA Pakistan team as they share the gift of the gospel with Muslim listeners this Christmas.

Monday 15 December: Pray for Christians in India, where many face opposition from relatives and society. FEBA's broadcasts offer biblical guidance on topics like mental health, life with disability, and cultivating healthy family relationships. Pray that more listeners in India will tune in this Christmas and discover hope and answers in God's living Word.

Tuesday 16 December: "I listened to FEBA's program on forgiveness. After our conversation over the phone, I am able to forgive my husband who was abusive towards me. Now I don't get angry and I'm able to sleep well. Thank you for your counsel to me regarding forgiveness." Thank God for bringing this listener in India peace through FEBA's broadcast.

Wednesday 17 December: "For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses" (Matthew 6:14-15 ESV). By God's immense grace, Jesus came to teach us how to forgive. Pray that FEBA listeners will demonstrate God's love to others through forgiveness.

Thursday 18 December: Did you know that today is Arabic Language Day? Let us lift up our Arabic-speaking brothers and sisters in prayer. Pray that those who follow Christ will be faithful witnesses to their neighbours, even in difficult circumstances, and that God will use FEBA's Arabic broadcasts to draw unbelievers to Him.

Friday 19 December: Pray for Mukul, FEBA's broadcaster who ministers to Muslims in India. He and other believers face a lot of resistance for their faith, yet people need the gospel. Pray that God will grant Mukul, his colleagues, and FEBA listeners faith and boldness in proclaiming the gospel, and that He will prepare people's heart to receive it.

Saturday & Sunday 20-21 December: More than 6,000 people accepted Christ during FEBA Thailand's 2023 Christmas Give with Love campaign. In 2024, that number rose to more than 11,000! The fundraising campaign commences in October, with special broadcasts and live events continuing until Christmas, when funds are used to buy gifts for underprivileged children. This year, FEBA Thailand is working with 450 churches and more than 4,000 volunteers to share the true meaning of Christmas with the unreached. Pray that God will bless FEBA Thailand's 2025 Give with Love campaign with abundant fruit.

Monday 22 December: Parts of the Philippines have suffered severe damage and loss of life this storm season, but FEBA Philippines continues to bring hope and comfort through God's Word. Pray for God's blessing on Director Luis Castillo and his team, and ask that they be filled with his Spirit as they proclaim His Word to their listeners.

Tuesday 23 December: Pray for FEBA Indonesia's ministry to a leprosy colony in Tangerang. The pastor there says, "It's true we are sick and poor, but we never beg for anything. We believe Jesus cares for us, and we feel God's care through Heartline FM (FEBA Indonesia)." Pray that marginalised people will find joy and comfort in the gospel this Christmas.

Wednesday 24 December: "'She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.' All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: 'Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel' (which means, God with us)" (Matthew 1:21-23 ESV).

Thursday 25 December: Praise God for the gift of His son and pray for FEBA's Christmas programs all over the world. Pray that God will use every broadcast to renew His children's faith and hope. Ask for His grace on unbelievers, that they will be moved to seek Him and discover eternal life through Jesus Christ.

Friday 26 December: Pray for FEBA's family programs all over the world. A poor economy, mental health struggles, addiction, and sometimes simply a lack of knowledge all have a detrimental impact on families. Pray that FEBA's family programs will bring healing through biblical principles and encourage every family to build their house on God's Word.

Saturday & Sunday 27-28 December: FEBA's ministry in Uzbekistan is bearing fruit, despite strong opposition. One broadcaster, a young mother who must hide her identity while working, says, "I risk my freedom and safety for one reason—eternal freedom and salvation for my listeners." The harvest in Uzbekistan is ripe, but more workers are needed, and churches lack the knowledge to nurture new converts into strong believers. Pray for the team as they train young evangelists to proclaim the gospel safely and effectively on social media and equip churches to make disciples.

Monday 29 December: Pray for FEBA Eurasia's youth ministry. In Ukraine, more than half of listeners who respond to broadcasts are under 30; in Kazakhstan, broadcasters are reaching their Muslim peers with the gospel; and in Moldova and Russia, FEBA's youth ministry is growing. Pray that FEBA's young broadcasters and listeners will grow in their walk with God.

Tuesday 30 December: In 2024, FEBA Russia's children's programs were viewed more than 1 million times. Zhenya, a 12-year-old from Siberia, says, "I never thought I could just talk to God like I talk to a friend. I now talk to Him every evening." Pray for Zhenya and other children across Russia as they build a relationship with God.

Wednesday 31 December: "In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins" (1 John 4:9-10 ESV). Praise God for His immeasurable love!
