

FEBA Radio SA's Prayer Missionaries Together in Prayer

January 2026

Thursday 1 January: Praise God for a new year! This year, FEBA Radio SA celebrates 30 years – and FEBC International 80 years – of bringing Christ to the world by media. Ask for His blessing on every FEBA program, project, and campaign this year. Pray that FEBA's staff and listeners will know His will and walk in a manner worthy of Him.

Friday 2 January: Did you know that FEBA has more than 42 million online streaming listeners worldwide? Every day, the internet and social media are opening new doors to share the gospel with more people, especially those in hostile environments. Pray that God will guide FEBA's social media ministry and bless it with abundant fruit.

Saturday & Sunday 3-4 January: On World Braille Day (4 January), let us lift up our visually impaired brothers and sisters in prayer. To many blind listeners, especially in poor countries, radio becomes a lifeline when they cannot leave their homes without assistance. Those who cannot read God's Word can hear it through FEBA's programs and audio Bibles, and when they contact FEBA's teams, the follow-up workers visit their homes where it is possible. Pray that every visually impaired listener will experience God's loving presence through FEBA's programs.

Monday 5 January: FEBA Thailand's Christmas campaign, Give with Love, sows thousands of gospel seeds each year and shares God's love with children through gifts. With its programs, FEBA strives to water every seed it plants. Ask God to bring the growth, and spend one minute to pray for one Thai person to put their faith in Christ.

Tuesday 6 January: FEBA Cambodia recently distributed audio devices filled with gospel content to 250 soldiers near the Cambodia-Thailand border. Later, one soldier said, "Before, I didn't know much about Jesus, but now I can hear His Word. Through this audio box, I've listened to many encouraging messages filled with God's love." Pray that these soldiers will put their faith in Christ.

Wednesday 7 January: "O Lord, you are my God; I will exalt you; I will praise your name, for you have done wonderful things, plans formed of old, faithful and sure" (Isaiah 25:1 ESV). Pray for God's will to be done and ask that his Name will be glorified through FEBA's work this year.

Thursday 8 January: Southeast Asia has experienced devastating floods in the past two months. Many people in parts of Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, Myanmar, and the Philippines have lost their homes and some their loved ones. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts will help them discover that God is close to the broken-hearted, and encourage them to put their trust in Him.

Friday 9 January: Pray for Noppakhun and the FEBA ELSEA (Ethnic Languages of Southeast Asia) team, who minister to more than 20 language groups in the mountains of Southeast Asia. Pray for God's protection over the teams where they travel. Ask that they will seek His will in all things and persevere in faith, until all have heard.

Saturday & Sunday 10-11 January: FEBA's ministry reaches millions of Muslims in Africa and Eurasia, and while there are great successes, there are also obstacles. One obstacle is a shortage of churches where Christians with a Muslim background feel welcome. A second obstacle is that some churches are too afraid of persecution to welcome new members. Pray that God will raise up more churches for Muslimbackground believers and that He will give churches the courage to partner with FEBA in discipling new believers.

Monday 12 January: There are about 20 million Muslims in Russia, ranging from extremists to cultural Muslims, and many engage with FEBA's broadcasts. Pray that Alexey and his team will follow God's guidance in their program production and in every conversation, so that they will find the best way to share the gospel with their listeners.

Tuesday 13 January: Pray that FEBA's Muslim listeners will see the truth, as this one did: "I hadn't read the Bible. I didn't even know what that verse was. But when I read it – 'faith, hope, and love, and the greatest of these is love' – I broke down in tears. I realised God had been calling me long before I even knew Him."

Wednesday 14 January: Our prayer for every listener who puts their faith in Christ through FEBA's broadcasts: "Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it" (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 ESV).

Thursday 15 January: Islam is the official religion of Malaysia and nearly 64% of the population practise it. It is illegal to share the gospel openly. Pray for Jonathan and his team, who are reaching out to Malaysian Muslims through online platforms. Ask that God will send more staff and inspire people to engage with FEBA's content.

Friday 16 January: Pray for FEBA's ministry to the Yao Muslims in Malawi, Mozambique, Tanzania, and Zambia. Ask God to prepare listeners' hearts for the seed of the gospel. Pray that Pastor Amos (Malawi), Bright (Mozambique), their teams, and their listeners will know the depth of Christ's love and the richness of God's provision.

Saturday & Sunday 17-18 January: FEBA has been sharing the gospel with Chinese people for 80 years, and FEBC Chinese Ministries is bigger than ever. In 2024, its programs were downloaded 88 million times, and in 2025, its theological seminary had more than 45,000 enrolled students. Yet the numbers pale in comparison to the transformation God has wrought in people's lives. Pray for Luke, Daniel, and their teams to remain rooted in love and prayer as they create content. Pray also that their listeners will receive the Good News with open hearts.

Monday 19 January: January is a month full of festivals in Japan – most of them in honour of Shinto traditions. Although Shintoism is so entrenched in Japanese culture, young people are increasingly open to the gospel. Pray for FEBA Japan to receive the wisdom to see every opportunity for sharing His Word, and the strength to seize it.

Tuesday 20 January: Pray for this listener in Japan, who says, "I was burdened for many years, due to my daughter's illness. While listening to your broadcast, I was reminded that everything is created by God – He's in control of our lives, and loves us unreservedly. Those words came straight to my soul, and I decided to accept my daughter as she is. Thank God that we're now set free!"

Wednesday 21 January: "Come to me, all who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30 ESV)

Thursday 22 January: The majority of Taiwan's population practises a mixture of Taoism, Buddhism, and Chinese folk religion, and there are thousands of deities worshipped all over the country. FEBA Taiwan's broadcasts in Taiwanese and Hakka are gaining popularity – the number of podcast listeners nearly doubled in one year! Pray that FEBA Taiwan's programs will bear lasting fruit.

Friday 23 January: South Korea has one of the highest suicide rates among developed countries. The stigma surrounding mental illness is still so strong that it prevents people from seeking help. Pray that people will find hope in the gospel through FEBA Korea's broadcasts, and that they will gain the confidence to ask for help.

Saturday & Sunday 24-25 January: FEBA Radio SA supports 12 radio stations in six countries in Africa, including four in the Sahel region, where the Muslim north meets the Christian south. All of these countries struggle with poverty, some with famine, and most with political instability and violent conflict. Pray for Dr Jurie Vermeulen, the national director, who leads FEBA's mission in Africa. Pray for the teams in Mozambique, Malawi, Mali, Chad, Niger, and Sudan. Ask that they will seek God's kingdom and His righteousness, and see rewards for their labour.

Monday 26 January: Living Hope Radio (FEBA Sudan) shares the gospel in an area where travel is difficult, and where conflict frequently claims lives. In just six months, its broadcasts have already created a positive impact in listeners' lives, encouraging believers and bringing non-believers to Christ. Thank God for His provision and ask for His protection over the station and staff.

Tuesday 27 January: A FEBA broadcaster in Sudan says, "I have seen that the people in Sudan are hungry for the Word of God, for peace, and for hope. Even with limited access to radios, those who manage to listen follow the programs faithfully, and some even record them for later listening." Pray that they will be filled up with the fullness of God!

Wednesday 28 January: Pray that Christ's followers will obey God's Word, which says: "So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation – if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good" (1 Peter 2:1-3 ESV).

Thursday 29 January: Pray for Ayata and the FEBA Chad team. They faithfully share the Good News in N'Diamena and the surrounding area, reaching ethnic minorities in their own languages. Pray that God will strengthen their faith in the face of resistance, and that they will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord.

Friday 30 January: Pray for FEBA's listeners in Africa who face opposition for their faith. Ask that they will stand strong in their faith and keep their eyes on the Father, so that their mourning may be turned to joy and draw others to Him. Praise God for His promise to provide for those who trust in Him.

Saturday & Sunday 31 January – 1 February: In countries like Uzbekistan and Tajikistan, evangelism is so dangerous that FEBA's broadcasters must conceal their identities. In Kyrgyzstan, listeners communicate with FEBA's presenters in secret, out of fear that their families will harm or reject them if the messages are discovered. All over Central Asia, the gospel is met with both hunger and resistance. Pray for Rudi and Victor, who oversee FEBA's ministry in Central Asia, and for the teams – that they will receive the strength to persevere in faith, hope, and love.
