



FEBA Radio SA's Prayer Missionaries

Together in Prayer

March 2026

Sunday 1 March: FEBA has been broadcasting to Pakistan since 1948, and the regional office was established in 1974. Today, FEBA Pakistan shares the Good News with listeners in spiritual and practical ways, and its follow-up workers spend hours to answer listeners' questions. Despite the resistance and hostility that Christians face, there are entire families who have come to know Christ through FEBA's broadcasts. Pray for Director Shahzad and his team as they continue to find new ways to share the gospel with listeners in Pakistan.

Monday 2 March: Pray for the people in Balochistan, Pakistan, who are frequently caught in the crossfire between authorities and separatist insurgents. The province is the largest but poorest in the country. Pray that FEBA Pakistan's broadcasts will reach listeners and allow them to encounter true peace through Jesus Christ.

Tuesday 3 March: Praise God for His continued blessing on FEBA Pakistan's ministry. One listener recently shared, "You have introduced me to a living, loving, and caring God and strengthened my faith and understanding of Christianity. Your program, Eternal Life, helped me receive eternal life through Jesus Christ." Ask that many more in Pakistan will receive eternal life through Christ.

Wednesday 4 March: "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him. Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will never be shaken" (Psalm 62:1-2 NIV). Pray that the believers in Pakistan who suffer persecution will find rest in God.

Thursday 5 March: There is a shift happening among non-Christian youth in Pakistan and they are becoming more open to the gospel. FEBA Pakistan's social media ministry is seeing a strong, positive response from young people and has received more than 100,000 views. Pray that every piece of content will plant a seed that bears lasting fruit.

Friday 6 March: Today is World Day of Prayer and this year's theme, selected by the women of Nigeria, is "I will give you rest: Come." Prayer has always been central to FEBA's ministry and God's rest is sorely needed all over the world. Pray for God's favour for all those who are praying in Jesus' name today.

Saturday & Sunday 7-8 March: FEBA Sudan is a young radio station facing steep challenges. While many are happy about the new station, there is also fierce opposition from local idol-worshippers, who seek to sabotage the team. Despite this, God is already working powerfully through FEBA Sudan's broadcasts, and FEBA Radio SA was able to send a consignment of radios to be distributed in the surrounding villages. Pray for God's protection over FEBA Sudan's hearts and minds, and the station's infrastructure. Ask that the new consignment of radios will help to expand His kingdom in Sudan.

Monday 9 March: Pray for Ayata, FEBA Chad's director, who is spending a month in Sudan to provide technical training and support to FEBA Sudan's inexperienced staff. The journey between Chad and Sudan is a difficult one. Pray that Ayata will return safely, and that his time with FEBA Sudan will bear abundant fruit.

Tuesday 10 March: "I feel that our radio station here is a gift from God to show that He really loves [us]. Many people have already tasted salvation through Living Hope Radio and are now very happy to hear [...] the Word of God being told in their mother tongues." Praise God for His work through FEBA Sudan and pray for revival throughout the country!

Wednesday 11 March: "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen ... By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible" (Hebrews 11:1,3 ESV). Let us pray that all God's children will be given unshakeable faith in Him.

Thursday 12 March: Pray for Khalid, who currently serves as FEBA Sudan's station coordinator. Pray that he and his team will stand strong in their faith and continue to do the work despite resistance. Ask for God's blessing over their health and families, and for His wisdom as they develop programs to share the gospel with their listeners.

Friday 13 March: RACE FM (FEBA Chad) is operating without its leader, Ayata, while he is in Sudan. Pray that operations will continue smoothly in his absence, and that the staff will remain diligent in their work of sharing the gospel with listeners in N'Djamena and surrounds. Ask that God will show favour to FEBA Chad's team and listeners.

Saturday & Sunday 14-15 March: In January, young people in Aceh, Indonesia, were mercilessly beaten for breaking sharia law. FEBA Indonesia broadcasts a program about living as a Christian where sharia law is enforced. The program aims to encourage believers and to inform non-believers about the Christian faith. The program has been well received so far, but caution remains vital. Pray for the Christians who live in parts of Indonesia where sharia law is in effect. Ask for God's protection and wisdom as FEBA Indonesia ministers to listeners there.

Monday 16 March: Pray for Yoke Pribadi, the director of FEBA Indonesia. He manages a huge, dynamic ministry in the country with the largest Muslim population on earth. This requires energy, shrewdness, tenacity, and a lot of courage. Pray for Yoke's physical and mental health, and ask that God will provide everything he needs to be a godly leader.

Tuesday 17 March: A listener from the leper community in Tangerang told FEBA Indonesia, "Through radio broadcasts, especially spiritual ones, I feel the presence of Jesus accompanying me during my days, even though I have been isolated from the world. I want to continue to share God's love with this world." Pray that those who feel rejected or lonely will find comfort in God's Word.

Wednesday 18 March: "I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living! Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!" (Psalm 27:13-14 ESV).

Thursday 19 March: Yancen and his team run FEBA Indonesia's youth program, ASIK! ("I love to follow Christ!"), which includes social media content, in-person gatherings, and training for young people to serve as digital evangelists. Pray that God will continue to inspire Yancen and his team, and that He will draw many young people to Him through the ASIK! program.

Friday 20 March: Pray for Radio PARS, FEBA Indonesia's Farsi-language broadcast for refugees. The broadcast takes the form of a weekly two-hour podcast, Voice of the Refugee, which reaches approximately 14,000 people in Jakarta and more around the world through social media. Pray that Farsi-speaking refugees will find Christ and community through Radio PARS.

Saturday & Sunday 21-22 March: Pray for the young people in Eurasia who are actively seeking the truth. Missionary organisations across the world have noted that young people are exceptionally open to the gospel – even in Muslim-majority countries where being Christian carries great risk. FEBA invests a lot in its youth ministry and the response has been amazing. Pray for FEBA's youth ministry teams in Russia, Ukraine, Moldova, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, and Turkmenistan. Pray for their safety, for inspiration and courage, and ask that their programs will bring transformation to the youth of Eurasia.

Monday 23 March: Fewer than 1% of children in Eurasia receive any Christian teaching. FEBA produces programs that teach children how to become “friends” with Jesus, and in Russia alone, these programs have received over 1 million views! Pray that God will use each program to introduce Himself to children, especially those in restrictive cultures or war-torn societies.

Tuesday 24 March: Pray for Ukraine’s youth, like 14-year-old refugee Serhii, whose father is serving on the front lines. Eduard (FEBA Ukraine’s director) writes, “Serhii came across one of our videos on TikTok and reached out to us. [We] invited him to attend our partners’ youth club. He came, found friends there, and began his journey of getting to know God – something he’d never encountered before.”

Wednesday 25 March: “ ‘Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it.’ And he took them in his arms and blessed them ...” (Mark 10:14-16 ESV). Pray that the youth in Eurasia will enter God’s kingdom.

Thursday 26 March: Pray for FEBA Kazakhstan’s youth ministry. FEBA’s TikTok videos often prompt young people to attend church, and the team regularly invite them to share a pizza at the studio, attend a youth gathering, or join them at church. Pray for God’s blessing on every interaction, so that it might lead young non-believers to Christ.

Friday 27 March: Pray for the young people in Uzbekistan, where Islam is harshly enforced. FEBA Uzbekistan creates short videos about biblical topics for social media and is passionate about drawing young viewers. Pray that God will give Umida and her team wisdom when they create content, and ask that young people will respond positively.

Saturday & Sunday 28-29 March: FEBA has been broadcasting programs for Yao listeners since 1991. What started as 15-minute shortwave radio programs has grown into a broadcasting ministry that spans shortwave radio, eight FM stations across Mozambique and Malawi, and a huge online audience. The Yao tend to be hostile to Christians, but the seeds planted through radio over more than 30 years are bearing great fruit. Pray that Yao communities in Malawi, Mozambique, and Tanzania will welcome FEBA’s teams, and open their hearts to the gospel.

Monday 30 March: Pray for the FEBA Radio SA team, which serves as support to all FEBA’s radio stations in Africa. The team experiences God’s protection and provision on a daily basis. Praise Him for His everlasting love, and ask that He will bless the FEBA Radio SA team with good health and spiritual growth this year.

Tuesday 31 March: “I used to be very critical of Christians. In fact, I always hated them because I was such a fervent believer in Islam. Today, I believe in Christianity more than Islam, though I have to speak and act in total secrecy, for my husband is a Muslim.” Pray that this FEBA Mali listener’s husband will put his faith in Christ.
