

FEBA Radio SA's Prayer Missionaries

Together in Prayer

April 2026

Wednesday 1 April: "Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in" (Psalm 24:7 ESV). As we approach Easter, let us praise God for His salvation and for the powerful way He uses FEBA to share that salvation with the world.

Thursday 2 April: In Africa, Muslims often practise a mixture of Islam and folk religion. So-called spiritual leaders and practitioners of magic control others through fear. Pray that FEBA's broadcasts in Mozambique, Malawi, and the Sahel region will break these strongholds through the gospel and introduce listeners to the Truth that can set them free.

Friday 3 April: "When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, 'It is finished,' and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit" (John 19:30 ESV). Christ, the author and finisher of our faith, completed our redemption through the shedding of His blood. This is the message FEBC and FEBA have faithfully proclaimed for 80 years. Praise the Lord!

Saturday & Sunday 4-5 April: "And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment, so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him" (Hebrews 9:27-28 ESV). Christ has risen and will return! Pray for FEBA's staff and listeners who suffer persecution, who feel scared or lonely or rejected, that their hope will be renewed by the same power that raised Christ from the dead.

Monday 6 April: During Ramadan, FEBA Mozambique aired special programs in which they explained "true fasting" to Muslims and pointed them to Jesus. Director Bright Sonjera reports that about 200 young people between the ages of 13 and 20 put their faith in Christ. Praise the Lord of the harvest and ask that every seed sown will bear lasting fruit.

Tuesday 7 April: When Shehe (sheikh) Abude, a Muslim scholar, suddenly lost his sight, he felt lost. Then he heard the gospel through FEBA Mozambique's Zambezi FM, and surrendered his life to Jesus. Today, he encourages other disabled people to do the same, saying, "I am born again. Now I believe God is looking after me." Pray that God will use Mr Abude's testimony powerfully.

Wednesday 8 April: "Lead me to the rock that is higher than I, for you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the enemy" (Psalm 61:2-3 ESV). Thank the Lord for protecting FEBA Mozambique's staff and the station throughout the conflict in Cabo Delgado so far, and for the soldiers who have come to faith. Pray for His continued favour.

Thursday 9 April: Pray for FEBA Mozambique's stations in Beira and Chiuanjota, which were forced off air by storm damage and technical problems. Pray for God's provision and protection over the restored infrastructure and over FEBA Mozambique's other radio stations, that the gospel can keep airing, until all have heard.

Friday 10 April: Ministry in Mozambique comes with many challenges, from logistical difficulties to jihadist conflict to opposition from communities where witch doctors reign. It takes strong, courageous leaders to guide teams through these waters. Pray for FEBA Mozambique's station managers and for Director Bright Sonjera. Ask that they will remain faithful to God's Word and walk closely with Him.

Saturday & Sunday 11-12 April: Shortwave radio has been central to FEBC and FEBA's ministry from the start. While expensive to maintain, shortwave stations have a massive reach and its signals are difficult to block. FEBC's two shortwave stations in Manila broadcast 24 hours a day, in 42 languages, and the teams receive feedback from the mountains of China and Cambodia and Thailand, countries like Laos and Vietnam – even countries in Europe! Pray for God's provision to keep FEBC's shortwave stations on air, so that even the hardest-to-reach people can receive the gospel.

Monday 13 April: Pray for believers in Vietnam. Even though Christianity is not illegal, evangelism is, and FEBC's team must use great caution in their follow-up work with listeners. Despite this, God has been working powerfully through FEBC Vietnam's programs since the 1950s. Pray for the safety and spiritual growth of FEBC workers and listeners in Vietnam.

Tuesday 14 April: A testimony from India: "God used your broadcasts as an instrument to change my life ... My current job does not make much in wages, but I buy tracts and give them to others like me, so that they will also know about Christ and about the love that changed me." Praise God and pray that more listeners will serve as faithful witnesses in their communities.

Wednesday 15 April: "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near" (Hebrews 10:24-25 ESV). Pray that FEBA's staff and listeners will persevere in faith until Christ returns.

Thursday 16 April: FEBC's Hmong broadcaster, Phairot, hosts Bible studies online and each one is attended by hundreds of Hmong listeners from countries like Laos, where Christianity is unwelcome. Pray for God's continued blessing on Phairot's broadcasts, and ask that his listeners will become deeply rooted in God's Word and bear godly fruit.

Friday 17 April: FEBC's shortwave broadcasts have been leading Lao listeners to Christ since the late 1960s. Today, Christians in Laos must practise their faith within strict government guidelines. Unless they belong to the Catholic or the Lao Evangelical Church, they must gather in secret. Pray that Lao believers will find courage and renewed hope in God's Word.

Saturday & Sunday 18-19 April: Since 1949, FEBC's Radio Liangyou has been broadcasting the gospel into China – first through shortwave and now through online streaming as well. Teams in Canada, the US, Taiwan, and Hong Kong produce the programs, which seek to bring hope in a tough political and economic climate, and to help families to strengthen their relationships according to biblical principles. Pray for the FEBC Chinese Ministries teams, who face challenges in their own countries, and ask that every program will kindle the gospel fire in listeners' hearts.

Monday 20 April: Today is International Chinese Language Day. In addition to its longstanding broadcasts to China, FEBC Chinese Ministries also collaborate with teams from other countries, like Indonesia and the Philippines, to air programs for Chinese-speaking listeners. Pray that Chinese-speaking listeners all over the world will encounter Christ through FEBC's Chinese broadcasts.

Tuesday 21 April: Pray for this Chinese listener from South Africa, who sent FEBC Chinese Ministries the following request: "My husband has not yet come to faith, and our marriage has faced many trials. Please pray that God will grant me strength and wisdom to fulfil my role as a wife – to learn daily to forgive, and to love my husband with God's love."

Wednesday 22 April: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you ..." (Isaiah 43:1-2 ESV). Pray that every FEBA worker and listener will experience God's nearness when they pass through deep waters.

Thursday 23 April: The Liangyou Theological Seminary allows people to study the Bible thoroughly and to complete foundational theological training. LTS's digital platform allows students to complete coursework in their own time, wherever they are, and pastors often use LTS content in their sermons. Pray that the LTS will lay a strong biblical foundation for church leaders in China to build on.

Friday 24 April: Pray for FEBC Chinese Ministries' leaders – Daniel, Aaron, Luke, and Edwin. Pray that they will keep their eyes on God and walk in His ways, that He will give them the strength and wisdom to overcome every obstacle, and that FEBC Chinese Ministries will flourish under their leadership.

Saturday & Sunday 25-26 April: Many FEBC workers and listeners live in war zones – some as soldiers, some as refugees, all of them dealing with fear and loss. Ukraine's team and their listeners are exhausted from poor sleep due to nightly bombardment, and insufficient heating due to power cuts. Listeners along the Cambodia-Thailand border and in the Middle East must deal with political instability and violence. Pray that FEBC's workers and listeners in war zones will receive strength and peace as they keep their eyes on God.

Monday 27 April: Today is Freedom Day in SA. Let us pray for those FEBC workers and listeners whose freedom is limited by authorities or by their communities. Ask that they will experience freedom through the gospel, and that God will help them to pray for their oppressors. Pray that their lives will point others to Christ and bring revival in their communities.

Tuesday 28 April: FEBC Cambodia collaborates with other organisations in bringing Bible teaching to remote areas. One student says, "The program has brought great joy to my heart. Even though conflict has happened between Cambodia and Thailand, which has affected our lives, we still desire to continue studying God's Word and growing in our faith." Pray that God will grant them their desire.

Wednesday 29 April: "Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us" (Psalm 62:8 ESV). Pray for believers all over the world who suffer because of war, illness, poverty, and persecution. Pray that their faith will be strengthened and that they will find refuge in God.

Thursday 30 April: Today, let us join FEBC Cambodia in its prayer: "All glory and honour belong to You, Lord. Through Krusa FM, You are moving mightily – calling hearts, awakening faith, and guiding listeners toward the way of righteousness through Jesus Christ. We praise You for the unseen moments where Your Spirit speaks through every broadcast and every spoken word."
