Together in Prayer

May 2026

Friday 1 May: FEBA's broadcasts accompany millions of workers on their daily commute, and sometimes even while they work. FEBA's programs teach listeners how to apply biblical principles in the workplace and deal with trials in a godly manner. Pray that all the workers who listen to FEBA's programs will glorify God's name through their work.

Saturday & Sunday 2-3 May: Flooding has caused widespread devastation in Mozambique and Malawi. Thousands of FEBA listeners, as well as some broadcasters, have lost their homes and belongings, with some staff members finding shelter on FEBA premises and others staying at rescue camps. Pray that God will intervene and bring relief. Ask that He will grant aid workers the energy and wisdom to provide the necessary help, and that He will use FEBA's broadcasts to bring comfort and strengthen listeners' faith.

Monday 4 May: Pray for Pastor Amos (Malawi) and Bright Sonjera (Mozambique) as they lead their teams and listeners who have been affected by the floods. Pray that God will grant them wisdom to solve problems and the strength to lend the necessary support. Ask also that they will persevere in faith and serve as godly leaders.

Tuesday 5 May: Praise God for this Cambodian listener's transformation: "Since I began listening [to Comfort at Night], my daily life has transformed; I have learned to be more patient and to approach my work with greater diligence. More importantly, when I feel anger rising, the program has taught me how to restrain it ..."

Wednesday 6 May: "Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear" (Isaiah 65:24 ESV). Praise God for His lovingkindness, which meets our needs before we even ask. Pray for His mercy and protection on all the FEBA workers and listeners who are caught up in natural and man-made disasters.

Thursday 7 May: FEBA Malawi's Chiyao programs broadcast to Tanzania via a shortwave transmitter in Eswatini. There are more than 300 listener clubs among Yao listeners and more Muslims joining out of curiosity every day. Pray for the safety of FEBA's coordinator in Tanzania, who travels between villages on a motorcycle, and for God's blessing on the Yao ministry in Tanzania.

Friday 8 May: Pray for FEBA Mozambique's youth ministry among the Yao and Makhuwa tribes, which are predominantly Muslim. The team proclaims the gospel through radio dramas, lifestyle programs for teenagers, and outside broadcasting. Pray for God's guidance in program production, for open hearts among young Muslim listeners, and for lasting fruit from FEBA Mozambique's labour.

Saturday & Sunday 9-10 May: Before Jesus ascended to heaven, He gave the disciples the Great Commission: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20 ESV). Pray that FEBC International will continue diligently to obey this command, and that listeners will become true disciples of Christ.

Monday 11 May: FEBC teams work hard to disciple listeners through personal interaction, discipleship programs, and by putting them in contact with local churches. It has become clear that many believers do not know how to disciple new converts. Pray that God will give FEBC the wisdom and opportunity to produce programs that address this need.

Tuesday 12 May: A listener recently told FEBC Thailand, "I listen to FEBC's program every day. It's great to receive encouragement from the program. I would like to request a Bible and your Bible Correspondence Course. I want to know and understand more about God." Pray that she will grow in faith as she studies God's Word.

Wednesday 13 May: "And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven'" (Acts 1:10-11 ESV). Amen!

Thursday 14 May: Today, we celebrate Christ's victorious ascension to heaven. As we look forward to His return, let us pray that God will continue to use FEBC in spreading the Good News in hard-to-reach places. Pray that every broadcast today will inspire believers to share the gospel with those who still need to hear it.

Friday 15 May: FEBC invests greatly in teaching families how to live according to God's will. A listener recently shared, "I was longing for the love of my family, because I came from a broken family. Thanks be to God, I know Him now, and I continue to pray that my family will become complete again." Pray that broken families will find healing through FEBC's broadcasts.

Saturday & Sunday 16-17 May: The Bible can be hard to navigate for people with a Buddhist background. To meet these people where they are, FEBC Thailand offers online Bible training in a very simple format designed for Buddhist-background believers. Students of all ages and from all walks of life (even prisoners) learn to engage with the Bible on fundamental themes like salvation and the Trinity. Pray that students of FEBC Thailand's Bible Correspondence Course will come to know God's Word as living and active in their lives.

Monday 18 May: FEBC Philippines director Luis Castillo oversees a huge ministry that ministers on air, online, and "on the ground". Its audience ranges from Muslims to mountain tribes to classical music enthusiasts in Manila. Pray that Luis and his team will keep their eyes on God and their hearts open to His guidance.

Tuesday 19 May: "I had been experiencing depression, but since I started listening to your radio station last year, my life has seen changes day by day." Pray that this listener from China will be completely healed of depression and that her testimony will draw others to God.

Wednesday 20 May: "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you" (John 14:26 ESV). Praise God for sending the Holy Spirit! Ask that every FEBC worker and listener will be aware of the Holy Spirit's work in their lives today.

Thursday 21 May: In Japan, Christians often experience a form of "polite persecution" – they are pressured to refrain from living out their faith, lest they give offence. Radio and digital evangelism are vital in such an environment. Pray that FEBC Japan's programs will inspire listeners to live as witnesses to Christ and draw non-believers to Him.

Friday 22 May: Pray for the underground church in North Korea, where being identified as a Christian leads to terrible punishment. FEBC Korea's broadcasts cover the entire North Korea, allowing defectors to reach their countrymen with the Good News. Pray for the safety of North Korean believers and ask that FEBC Korea's broadcasts will comfort and encourage listeners in their faith.

Saturday & Sunday 23-24 May: In accordance with God's promise, He sent the Holy Spirit to serve as a Helper, Counsellor, and Comforter of believers. FEBC's ministry would be futile without the Holy Spirit working in people's hearts to hear and understand the gospel. Praise God for giving us the Spirit of truth to help us pray. Pray that He will work in listeners' hearts wherever they hear a FEBC broadcast today and inspire them to surrender to Christ.

Monday 25 May: Three FEBA directors from Sahel countries are travelling to South Africa to participate in the 30th anniversary celebrations on 30 May (Pretoria) and 6 June (Cape Town). Pray that Godi, M'Bimba, and Ayata will arrive safely and that the radio stations in Niger, Mali, and Chad will continue operating smoothly in their absence.

Tuesday 26 May: In response to conflict in the surrounding communities, FEBA Sudan has produced a program about peacebuilding and trauma healing. One listener recently said, "Through the program on peacebuilding, many families and communities are able to reconcile and have peace. Thanks be to God!" Pray that the new consignment of radios will spread the gospel of peace throughout the region.

Wednesday 27 May: Please pray for FEBA Africa and FEBC International: "Finally, brothers [and sisters], pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you, and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men. For not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful" (2 Thessalonians 3:1-3 ESV).

Thursday 28 May: FEBA Niger introduced online streaming in March, allowing more listeners to access their broadcasts, in greater privacy. Persecution is a major concern among new believers, as the rejection of their families usually leaves them without a home or income. Pray that FEBA Niger's online streaming will yield a great harvest and encourage believers to persevere in faith.

Friday 29 May: Pray for FEBA Mozambique's youth discipleship program in Cuamba. The team has trained a group of young people to assist them in producing programs through outside broadcasting. They travel between villages around Cuamba to share the gospel, raise awareness around HIV, and educate people to stop child marriages. Pray that these programs will bring lasting change among listeners.

Saturday & Sunday 30-31 May: The pervasive, ongoing conflict in the Sahel region has left more than 4 million people displaced so far, with the number expected to exceed 5 million by the end of 2026. More than 42 million people require aid. All of them need the gospel. FEBA broadcasts in Chad, Mali, Niger, and Sudan, sharing the Good News and teaching listeners how to be peacemakers in the midst of violence. Pray that God will protect and provide for FEBA's teams and listeners in the Sahel region.
