Together in Prayer

September 2026

Tuesday 1 September: Alisa, a ten-year-old FEBC Moldova listener, says, "Since your videos came into my life, I started to have a real relationship with God. I pray more, I want to share God's Word with others, do more good, forgive people, and thank God for everything!" Pray that Alisa and the young people of Moldova will grow ever closer to the Lord.

Wednesday 2 September: "Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. Every athlete exercises self-control in all things ..." (1 Corinthians 9:24-25 ESV). Pray that FEBA's staff will set an example of self-control for listeners.

Thursday 3 September: FEBC Moldova ministers to many listeners from dysfunctional families, where relationships have suffered due to alcoholism and neglect. Pray for the teams who engage with listeners who reach out for help, that they will be sensitive to the Holy Spirit's guidance, and pray that FEBC's programs will bring healing to Moldovan families through the gospel.

Friday 4 September: FEBC Moldova trains influencers to share the gospel on social media. Two influencers, Ivan and Chris, receive great feedback on their videos, with people repenting and putting their faith in Christ. However, some also share their struggles with suicidal thoughts. Pray that God will guide Ivan and Chris to respond to listeners with wisdom and sensitivity.

Saturday & Sunday 5-6 September: FEBA Mozambique's ministry is bearing abundant fruit. In July, as the team travelled around Niassa province and staged live broadcasts from villages, they encountered open hearts. Three armed robbers showed up at an event with ill intent, only to hear the Good News and repent! Children, lost in despair because of poverty and grief, heard FEBA's message on an old radio and joined the youth discipleship program, which shares the gospel through radio dramas. Pray that every hungry heart in Mozambique will receive the Bread of Life through FEBA's broadcasts.

Monday 7 September: FEBA Malawi received a new consignment of 2-in-1 radio/audio Bible devices in July and immediately started sharing them with listener club leaders. Pray that God will use each device to expand His kingdom and that He will provide FEBA with all they need to bring in the harvest.

Tuesday 8 September: Did you know that only about 35% of Mali's population can read? This FEBA Mali listener says: **"Since KanuYah FM led me to Christ, my faith has been growing thanks to the Christian broadcast in Bambara, Mandingo and Kassonké. Being an illiterate person, I only understand the local languages."** Praise God for radio!

Wednesday 9 September: "'For the mountains may depart and the hills be removed, but my steadfast love shall not depart from you, and my covenant of peace shall not be removed,' says the Lord, who has compassion on you" (Isaiah 54:10 ESV). Pray that FEBA Africa's teams and listeners in dangerous circumstances will draw strength from God's promises.

Thursday 10 September: FEBA Chad has taken to the streets of N'Djamena! The team hosts shows in different neighbourhoods, in which they employ various art forms to share the gospel. Pray for creativity and inspiration, for audiences that are open to the gospel, and for wisdom when FEBA Chad follows up with those who want to learn more about the gospel.

Friday 11 September: In Niger, being Christian in the countryside can bring about terrible consequences. In urban areas, people are willing to hear and even accept the gospel, but only in secret, lest their families cut them off. Pray that FEBA Niger will have the boldness to share the gospel and the strength to support believers who suffer persecution.

Saturday & Sunday 12-13 September: FEBC has been broadcasting to Thailand since 1951. Today, the country is still 99.23% Buddhist and some provinces, like Udon Thani, are only 0.25% Christian. After being invited by a church in Udon Thani, FEBC began working with 17 churches from three denominations to unite them, not in name but in mission, because unity is vital to effective ministry. Pray for FEBC Thailand's project in Udon Thani and pray that Christians everywhere will work as one body to share the gospel with others.

Monday 14 September: FEBC Thailand has permission to conduct outreach programs and worship services in certain prisons, and prisoners are allowed to participate in FEBC's Bible Correspondence Course. This teaches them that they are never out of God's reach and never too far gone to be saved. Pray for God's blessing and guidance over FEBC Thailand's prison ministry.

Tuesday 15 September: A listener in Thailand shared, **"When FEBC helped explain the Bible to me, it made me feel closer to God's Word. It also helped me know that God loves and cares for me."** Praise God! Pray that FEBC Thailand's Bible teaching will draw more listeners to Him and deepen their understanding of His Word.

Wednesday 16 September: "Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom" (James 3:13 ESV). Pray that the worldwide church will walk in a manner worthy of the gospel, in meekness and wisdom, and so draw lost souls to Christ.

Thursday 17 September: FEBC Thailand recently launched a new program, Ask Christian, that tackles tough questions without fear. Its first season drew over 1 million views and 40 000 responses, many from non-Christians who pushed back and argued, but stayed. Pray that the program host will receive the wisdom needed to engage with listeners and that the program will bear abundant fruit.

Friday 18 September: FEBC Thailand is participating in a project called "Thailand 1-1-1", which aims to see 1 million Thai Christians, 10 000 churches, and 10 000 pastors in Thailand by 2028. Pray for FEBC Thailand's director, Sumet, and his team as they work to share the gospel through media, and pray for one Thai person to come to Christ today.

Saturday & Sunday 19-20 September: So many people in Sudan are waiting to hear the gospel, but tribal conflict escalated to new heights in July, forcing FEBA's station to remain closed for seven weeks. Our station manager risked his life to protect the station equipment. We praise God that we were able to re-open the station on 18 August! Please pray for a lasting peace between the tribes. Pray that FEBA Sudan will not be discouraged by setbacks but rather more motivated to share the gospel, and that people will be more willing to hear it.

Monday 21 September: Please pray for Dr Jurie Vermeulen, FEBA Radio SA's director, and for his team. This year has brought great blessing through our 30th birthday celebrations, but it has also brought challenges for the staff. Pray that God will strengthen the team in times of illness and struggle, and will display His perfect strength in our weakness.

Tuesday 22 September: **"I was hesitant when I first started listening ... But you kept bringing on Rabbis who talked about God in a way that I had never heard. I wanted to know more, so I visited the church that you recommended. It was so full of life and joy. Now I am a follower of Jesus!"** Pray that FEBC Ukraine's program will draw more Jewish listeners to Christ.

Wednesday 23 September: "For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God" (Ephesians 2:18-19 ESV). Pray that FEBC listeners will find joy and comfort in this good news!

Thursday 24 September: Heritage can be a source of pride, but in many cases, it also motivates persecution. Many FEBC listeners in Africa and Southeast Asia have been displaced because of ethnic conflicts. Pray that FEBC's programs will promote unity and peace through the gospel, and that listeners will serve as peacemakers in their communities.

Friday 25 September: Pray for the leadership of FEBC International. Pray for the necessary wisdom to recognise and use the right opportunities to proclaim the gospel through media; for the patience and compassion needed to lead teams from diverse backgrounds; and for continued faithfulness in pursuing FEBC's mission, until all have heard.

Saturday & Sunday 26-27 September: Did you know that more than 1600 languages have no Bible translation? FEBC International's mission is to bring Christ to those unreached people groups by media. Wherever we work, we employ speakers of local dialects to translate and present the gospel to their own communities. The harvest is ripe, but the workers are few. Pray that the Lord will send people to help FEBC broadcast in new languages, and that He will prepare unreached communities to receive His Word.

Monday 28 September: Pray for Nopp, the director of FEBC ELSEA (Ethnic Languages of Southeast Asia), and for his team, who face all kinds of physical and spiritual challenges as they minister to ethnic minorities in Southeast Asia. Pray that they will find courage in God's nearness and that their testimony will draw lost souls to Him.

Tuesday 29 September: No matter where we are, He finds a way to give us His loving encouragement, as He does with this South Korean listener: **"I listen to FEBC every day while working as a delivery driver. The broadcasts give me grace and encouragement, even when I am tired. I hope to share the gospel now with friends."** Praise God!

Wednesday 30 September: "Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people" (Revelation 14:6 ESV). No matter the language, God's children will hear the Good News! Pray that FEBC's ministry will continue to advance the gospel despite opposition.
